

FEB. 28, 1966 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance called on the Rev. Mack Tribble, new pastor of the First Methodist Church, for the invocation.
2. Minutes of Feb. 14 meeting read and approved.
3. City School Supt. G. V. Cate advised Council that the school needed \$15,000 to complete the latest construction program. Ald. David made a motion to grant this amount, Ald. Norton 2nd and the vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.
4. Ald. David moved that the loan from MR. & Mrs. A. W. Sherman be renewed. Ald. Woods 2nd and carried.
5. Ald. David heard in the matter of a water tap for Mrs. A. N. Jones of Resaca. Mr. Owens advised that Mrs. Jones would have to pay for pipe to run to the public road or get Mr. A. H. DeFoor to deed the private road to the county.
6. Ald. King proposed to designate Asst. Fire Chief Ward and Fireman Grizzle captains so that each would be in charge of the shift he works (in the absence of the chief). Captain Grizzle's pay to be increased \$12 per mo. to \$355 effective immediately. Mr. Ward to retain position of Asst. Fire Chief. Council ok'd.
7. Ald. King moved to employ a part time fireman to work every Saturday so that the regular firemen may have an additional day off each month. Buddy Autry recommended for this duty. Ald. David seconded the motion which was voted on and passed.
8. Ald. King moved the adoption of the abbreviated edition of the Fire Prevention Code. Ald. David 2nd, voted and passed.
9. Ald. King made motion to appropriate up to \$18,000 toward the purchase of a new 750 GPM pumper fire truck with hose and equipment. Ald. David 2nd, voted and passed.
10. Ald. King said the new truck could be housed in the present fire hall by altering the rear of the building to lower the floor.
11. Ald. King suggested advertising for bids on the '63 Chevrolet police car reserving the right to refuse any and all bids.
12. Ald. King made motion to adopt an ordinance restricting the use of blue flasher lights to police vehicles only. Ald. Norton seconded and the motion passed. City attorney to draw ordinance.
13. Council agreed to reduce the \$100 water tap fee to \$50 from Antioch Church south along ~~Needmore~~ Dews Pond Road.
14. Ald. King moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. Woods and done.
