

AUGUST 22, 1966 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT EXCEPT ALD. A. JERRY KING.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of August 8 meeting read and approved.
3. David Lynch expressed appreciation to the Police Dept. for checking entrances to business establishments to ascertain if they are locked and again requested Council to require Vern Kuhlman to enclose his swimming pool. Mayor Dickinson advised that Mr. Kuhlman had promised to do this as soon as contractor Raymond King was available to build the fence.
4. Co. Comm. Everett DeFoor and Co. Atty. J. C. Maddox asked Council to pay the City's pro rata share of the tax equalization program, i. e. \$22,500, with the final amount to be adjusted later. Ald. David moved that the City comply with the County's request. Ald. Norton seconded and the motion was approved.
5. Ald. David made a motion to accept the dedication, from the County, of Dew's Pond Road from the present city limits to Barrett Road. Ald. Norton seconded and the motion passed.
6. Ald. David sought and received Council approval for 3 men to attend the CD Radiological Monitoring Instructors Course in Atlanta on Sept. 12-18.
7. Nelson Warren asked Council to re-zone his property on Red Bud Road from R-1 to C-1. He was advised to contact the Zoning Board of Appeals.
8. Supt. Owens heard in the matter of Astro Dye's power bill. No action taken.
9. Housing Authority Director J. C. Boyd said a street light was needed at the east end of the project. Supt. Owens to check and handle.
10. Ald. Woods said an additional street light should be installed on Oothcaloga St. at the high school. Referred to Supt. Owens.
11. Ald. David reported that his CD unit had been asked to participate in recovering a body from Lake Allatoona and would send men Tuesday morning.
12. Ald. David suggested the clerk notify Mr. Frank Thomas that the City was not yet ready to enter into a contract with a fiscal agent on the proposed sewer improvements. Council concurred.
13. Ald. Norton moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. Woods and done.
