


JUNE 13, 1966 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT
EXCEPT ALD. A. J. KING.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of May 23 meeting read and approved.
3. Council approved request of Calhoun Drug Co. for a public (pay station) telephone to be installed on sidewalk on Park Avenue adjacent to Calhoun Drug bldg.
4. Council referred Cleophas Mann's request for a street light between Oothcaloga & Court Sts. on Fair St. to Supt. Owens to handle.
5. Council declined to install speed breakers on any street for the present.
6. Council discussed the lack of enclosures about swimming pools and instructed the clerk to notify Mr. Vern Kuhlman again that he must have a fence around his pool. Mr. D. F. "Preacher" Williams, Jr. to be advised that his new pool must be enclosed.
7. David Lynch, having presented a petition signed by some 17 residents of Cherry Hill Drive, told the Council that speeding autos were endangering the lives of all in their neighborhood. Mayor Dickinson instructed Chief Roberts to seek the aid of the Ga. State Patrol if necessary to curb speeding in the city.
8. Supt. Owens said Mr. Raymond Halston had approached him in regard to Echota Baptist Church doing some construction work without a Business License. Council advised that someone must have a license on this job.
9. At Ald. Woods' suggestion, Council approved installation of 2,000 ft. of 6" C. I. water main on Dew's Pond Rd. for 7 users at \$4 per month minimum charge.
10. Council agreed that the two young men wishing to sell books published by the Southwestern Co. of Nashville, Tenn. must comply with city ordinances governing the same.
11. Chief Roberts told Council that he would be on vacation from June 23 to July 5.
12. Ald. David moved to adjourn, Ald. Woods seconded and the meeting was adjourned.
