


APRIL 11, 1966 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of March 28 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Norton said all business concerns in the city should be notified to comply with section 9 of the City Code in order to eliminate littering of streets, sidewalks and alleys. Council agreed and instructed the clerk to so inform the merchants.
4. Council appointed J. D. Anderson, Sr., S. M. Harrison and J. C. Boyd to serve, without remuneration, as the city's Zoning Board of Appeals.
5. Council ordered the clerk to notify owners of sub-standard houses and buildings that those who have received prior notice will have ten (10) days from date of this notice to comply with minimum standards of the city code, or the city will take necessary action to bring this property into compliance with the code or wreck and remove the buildings and/or houses.
6. Ald. Woods heard in the matter of auto parking on both sides of Chandler St. and thereby obstructing the normal flow of traffic. Council ordered Chief Roberts to stop this illegal parking immediately.
7. Ald. Woods suggested that city prisoners be utilized to keep litter off the streets, especially on the east side of River St. near the city dump.
8. Ald. David announced that bids on the new airport would be opened at the City Hall at 10 AM on Tues., April 12.
9. Ald. David made a motion to appropriate \$4,000 to pay for architectural and engineering services on the new library. Ald. King seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
10. Supt. Owens said he would like for W & L Supt. Jack Bell and M. J. West to attend the electric meter school at Gainesville, Fla. the week of April 18-23. Council approved.
11. Supt. Owens reported that several residents of the Hunt Subdivision had not yet connected to the city's sanitary sewer main. Clerk instructed to give these property owners due notice that this must be done.
12. Ald. Norton moved to adjourn, Ald. King seconded and the meeting was adjourned.
