


MAY 9, 1966 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT EX-  
CEPT ALD. W. R. NORTON.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the April 25 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. David said Miss Mary Johnson had complained of bottles being thrown into her back yard from Griffin's Drive In parking lot. Council offered no solution.
4. Kenneth Taylor present asking city to install a water main in his Skyline Subdivision. He said he had paid for 6 taps and requested that the main be installed before he had the streets paved. Supt. Owens to check and report to the Council.
5. Ald. David asked and received permission for the Mayor to sign FAA required papers with regard to lights at Tom B. David Field.
6. Ald. David requested and was granted approval to place directional signs on utility poles for the Boy Scout Hikeorama.
7. Ald. Woods said he would like to see a drive cut through the new section of Fain Cemetery prior to the opening of this section. Council ordered the chain replaced at the entrance to Chandler Cemetery.
8. Ald. King's request that the Council go into executive session was granted and shortly thereafter, the Council advised that an agreement with Atlanta Gas Light Co. had been reached re franchise renewal.
9. Council approved grant agreement with FAA on Tom B. David Field on motion of Ald. King, 2nd of Ald. David.
10. Supt. Owens reported some difficulties were being encountered in the opening of graves. Council ordered a letter be sent to the funeral directors stating that the sexton must be notified in advance of the opening of any graves in Fain or Chandler.
11. Supt. Owens said Harry Lawrence had asked for a letter from the city agreeing to furnish utilities in ~~Woods~~ Hills Subd. Council agreed with the stipulation that sewer service (sanitary) would be furnished only where available by gravity flow.
12. Ald. Woods heard in regard to extending water main along Red Bud Rd. Council said the old petition on file would have to be brought up to date.
13. Council agreed that the water main on Dew's Pond Rd. would not be extended further until the Co. Comm. relented from his stand with regard to repairing roads. This order applies also to E. May St. extension.
14. On motion of Ald. King, 2nd of Ald. David, Council unanimously approved adoption of resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign a request for a 30% grant from the Federal Water Pollution Control Adm. under Public Law 660 to assist in construction of improvements to city's sanitary sewerage system.
15. Ald. King moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. David and done.
