

NOV. 14 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT EXCEPT
ALD. W. R. NORTON.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Oct. 24 meeting read and approved.
3. The city's consulting engineer, Bill Greene, of Wiedeman & Singleton, recommended that the city proceed with sewage treatment facilities even without the EDA grant we had hoped to get. Council agreed and told Mr. Greene he would be notified if the city wished to halt proceedings at some future date.
4. Frank Thomas, Jr. of Frank Thomas & Co, Birmingham, Alabama was a visitor to the meeting and discussed financing of the sewage treatment plant with the Council.
5. Ald. King announced that two new policemen would report for duty on Sunday, Nov. 20 with an additional man to start later.
6. Ald. Woods discussed the opening and closing of graves in Fain and Chandler cemeteries by city forces which becomes effective Jan. 1, '67.
7. Ald. David re airport dedication. No date set as yet. Council agreed to readvertise the electrical contract for the airport.
8. Council discussed the freak accident in which Mrs. J. N. (Aileen) Holcomb hit a man hole cover on N. Wall St. causing considerable damage to her car. It was decided to check with the city attorney, prior to offering any settlement of the claim.
9. Supt. Owens said parking should be eliminated on the East side of Piedmont St. from O'Callaghan to Line St. Police Comm. to look into this and make recommendation.
10. Supt. Owens advised Council that several vehicles were in need of replacement. Council told Mr. Owens to accept bids on a new garbage truck immediately.
11. Supt. Owens said Southland Mills was planning a laundry at the old location of Ga. Tufters. Mr. Owens said this would create quite a sewer problem.
12. Ald. David moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. King and done.
