


MARCH 14, 1966 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT
EXCEPT ALD. ARDEN J. KING.

1. Rev. Fred Hill, pastor of the Calhoun Presbyterian Church, delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Feb. 28 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. David announced there would be a Civil Defense meeting in Atlanta on March 22, 23 & 24. Mr. David said he planned to attend and take one man with him. Council approved.
4. Ald. David proposed to pay Mary Johnson 1/3 of the \$8500.00 cost for land and clear zone and approach easements for the airport. Balance to be paid in two equal annual installments at 4% int. Council approved.
5. Supt. Owens heard in regard to Americana Carpets request for water east of I-75. Discussed by council, no action.
6. Supt. Owens reported that Astro Dye Works had been billed for electricity at rates considerably less than the city's cost since August of 1964. The difference in the amount Astro paid and should have paid is \$12,871.70. Mr. Owens and the City Clerk to contact Mr. Paul J. Smith, president of Astro, to explain this error.
7. Ald. Norton made a motion to amend the business certificate ordinance to permit general repair contractors to take contracts up to \$200 for the same fee as charged electrical contractors, i. e. \$25. Ald. David seconded and the motion passed.
8. Supt. Owens said the 12" water main on ~~King~~^{River} St. should be extended approx. 1,000 ft. Council approved.
9. Mayor Dickinson suggested increasing water volume and pressure in the city where needed.
10. On motion of Ald. David with second from Ald. Woods, the property of Standard Oil Co., Atlantic Rugs, Inc. and that property of Echota Cotton Mills west of US 41 was annexed to the city as of Jan. 1, 1966. (Petitions attached with descriptions.)
11. Ald. Woods heard in regard to furnishing city sewerage service for residents of Wilson St. Supt. Owens said with an easement from Raymond Bagwell, all this area except a section south of Talley Ave. could be served by this summer.
12. Ald. David moved to adjourn, Ald. Norton 2nd and done.
