City Council met in regular session, the following members present: Mayor Protém, Tom David; Aldermen: Caldwell, Edwards, and Woods. Mayor Lawrence absent at this time.


Mayor Protém, Tom David opened the meeting and requested that Chief Hayes lead in prayer.

1. Mr. David welcomed delegation from Resaca who were present to check on chances of getting water in the near future. Mr. Woods read a letter from McWane Cast Iron Pipe Co. stating that pipe deliveries were behind from 60 to 90 days. Mr. David promises will complete line as soon as possible.
 2. Mr. Ben Stone of New Town District reports that he is without water. He is approximately 1/2 mile from Jones Cross Roads. Discussed as to whether 2" pipe would be sufficient. Mr. David requested Mr. McDaniel to investigate and report to council. Promises Mr. Stone water if at all possible.
 3. Edward Long present in regard to Beer license. Mr. David asked Council to hold up on decision until next meeting when Mayor Lawrence would be present.
 4. Minutes of last meeting read and approved. Minutes of call meeting of the 15th. read.
 5. Mr. Woods heard in regard to water standing in front of Mr. Norman Miller's house. Asks Mr. McDaniel to check on this.
 6. Mr. Edwards heard in regard to Rodeo coming to Calhoun October 16th. and 17th. sponsored by the American Legion. The legion to get 30% of the proceeds, half of which is to be donated to the Civic Center. States that there are no carnival gambling devices. Mr. Edwards made motion that this Rodeo be allowed to come to Calhoun. Seconded by Mr. Caldwell, voted on and passed.
- No other business. Mr. Caldwell made motion to adjourn. Seconded by Mr. Woods, voted on and passed.
