

November 8, 1955

City Council met in regular session, the following members present: Mayor Lawrence; Aldermen: Mr. Caldwell, Mr. Edwards, and Mr. Woods. Mr. David absent at this time.


Mayor Lawrence led in prayer, after which the following business was conducted:

1. Minutes of last meeting read and approved. Minutes of Special meeting in regard to W. D. Hall case of October 31, 1955 read and approved. Minutes of Call meeting of November 1, 1955 in regard to new reservoir read and approved.
  2. Mrs. Ponders, Mrs. Brackett, Mrs. Thomas, and Mr. Kirby, residents of Wonder street heard in regard to paving on Wonder street. Street in front of Mrs. Ponders house is ready for paving if Red Shepherd pays his part. Other part of Wonder street discussed. Mr. McDaniel, Mayor and Aldermen view the Plat to determine how much each resident owns. Mr. Kirby, one of the residents of Wonder street, to see Mr. Patterson and Mr. Talley and get them to put up the money for their part. Also Dr. Lang is to be notified as to how much he is to pay for his property. After these three pay, Wonder street will be ready for paving. While work is being done over on Wonder street Mrs. Thomas would like to have her driveway fixed.
  3. Mrs. Ponders in regard to light being out on Wonder street.
  4. Mr. Dobson in regard to pin ball machines. After discussion Mr. Caldwell made motion to leave as is and definitely veto pin ball machines. Seconded by Mr. Woods, voted on and unanimously passed.
  5. Police Committee, Mr. Caldwell, and Mr. Edwards, to have pin ball machine at Lee Evans beer parlor taken out Wednesday morning November 9, 1955.
  6. Council to see Miss Gardner about cutting two trees in front of her house which are in the way of widening the street.
  7. Mayor Lawrence read letter from J. G. B. Erwin in regard to curb and gutter in front of his house on Trammell street.
  8. Mayor Lawrence read letter from Mr. Cunningham in regard to Civic Center. Discussed basement and how to fix it up ready for use by the first of the year. After discussion they decided to call a Special meeting to be held at 12:30 on Wednesday November 9, 1955 in the Courtroom at the City Hall. Mayor, Aldermen, Mr. McDaniel and Bill Defoor to be present.
- No other business. Mr. Caldwell made motion to adjourn. Seconded by Mr. Woods, voted on and passed.
