August 23, 1955

City Council met in regular session, the following members present: Mayor Lawrence, Mr. Caldwell, Mr. David, and Mr. Edwards. Mr. Woods was absent at this time, being away at National Guard Camp.

Mayor Lawrence opened the meeting and asked Chief Hayes to lead in prayer, after which the following business was conducted:

1. Mr. Cunningham, architect from Atlanta present and heard in regard to work to be done on Civic Center Building. Asks what part of work Council desires to be let out for bids. Would suggest that the front be done under contract, and possibly the steel work for the second floor, the City to do stairs and other work. Mayor Lawrence suggests asking for bids for sections. Mr. Cunningham states he will prepare blue prints for bids and notify contractors the day to inspect bids.
 2. Mayor Lawrence reads letter from School Board asking for \$ 45,000 to operate schools for 1955-56.
 3. Mayor Lawrence heard in regard to authorizing Acting City Clerk to withdraw funds in the amount of \$ 15,187.50 from the Water & Sewer Construction Fund to pay note due at Calhoun National Bank. This money having been borrowed to make water extensions prior to receiving money on Water Revenue Certificates. Mr. Edwards made motion that the Acting City Clerk be authorized to pay note from Water & Sewerage Construction Fund. Seconded by Mr. David, voted on and passed.
 4. Mr. David heard in regard to 3rd. Annual Festival. States carnival will be here Sunday, September 4th. for one week, and wants authority from the City Council to furnish Electricity up to \$ 50.00, also wants street cleared for street dance on Thursday night. Mr. Caldwell made motion that this authority be given. Seconded by Mr. Edwards, voted on and passed.
 5. Mr. David heard in regard to Water extended beyond Deans store beyond Resaca. Council advises will install if customers buys pipe.
 6. Mr. Caldwell in regard to leak on North Wall Street in front of Stewarts apartment house. Mr. McDaniel states this leak to be fixed at once and hole patched with hot mix.
 7. Mr. Edwards heard in regard to paving American Legion detour road. Mr. Caldwell made motion to pay 2/3 of paving on County barn drive if the county will pay 1/3 of cost. Seconded By Mr. Edwards, voted on and passed.
 8. At this time there was discussion in regard to Atlanta Gas Light Co. tearing up city streets. Mr. McDaniel to figure cost of repair and send bill to the Gas Co.
 9. Mr. David heard in regard to traffic congestion on South Wall Street. Especially in front of Velvetone Mills. Tabbed until next meeting.
 10. Mr. Edwards heard in regard to Fleet insurance Policy on City equipment. Mr. David states he is still deliberating and will present plan at next meeting when Mr. Woods is present.
- No other business, Mr. David made motion to adjourn. Seconded by Mr. Caldwell, voted on and passed.
