November 22, 1955

City Council met in regular session, all members present. City Engineer,
Alton McDaniel Absent at this time.

Mayor Lawrence called the meeting to order and asked Chief Hayes to
lead in prayer, after which the following business was conducted:-----

1. Minutes of last meeting read and approved.
2. Mayor Lawrence heard in regard to Civic Center. This work to begin
at once, under the jurisdiction of Mr. Defoor. The Masonic Order
is to take charge of the 3rd. floor.
3. Mr. Fred Carter heard in regard to Masonic members doing work them-
selves, or if agreeable all members agree to pay a percentage of cost
instead of a part donating labor. Mr. Carter advises Masons will
meet on 6th. of December and report decision at the next Council
meeting.
4. Mr. Edwards heard in regard to side walk on Piedmont street being
broken by Colonial trucks. This to be repaired as soon as possible.
Also street on Fair street in front of Blanche Gardner's house need-
ing gravel where pipe line was dug.
5. Mayor Lawrence states that Sam Hunt will donate Christmas tree for
Court House lawn if City will place and decorate it. Mr. Caldwell
agrees to take care of this.
6. Mayor Lawrence heard in regard to shooting Gallery in City. No action
taken as shooting in City is prohibited by Law.
7. Mayor Lawrence advises that curbing and guttering work progressing
nicely.
8. Mr. Edwards made motion that Mr. Frank Dobbs hold the City Election
on December 14, 1955, at a price of \$ 30.00. Election to be held
from 7:00 A. M. to 6:00 P. M. Motion seconded by Mr. Caldwell, voted
on and passed.
9. Mr. Edwards heard in regard to equalizing insurance. As amounts not
too much out of line, No action taken at this time.
10. Mr. David heard in regard to hold in street in front of Delux Dry
Cleaners. Mr. McDaniel to take care of this.

No other business, Mr. David made motion to adjourn. Seconded by Mr.
Woods, voted on and passed.
