

Calhoun, Georgia  
April 11, 1955

City Council met in regular session, all members present.

Mayor Lawrence opened meeting and asked Chief Hayes to lead in prayer, Then the following business was conducted.

1. Mayor Lawrence welcomes visitors and invites any comments or requests.
2. Mr. George Cochran of Victory Drive, heard in regard to lack of water on South Victory Drive. Mr. McDaniel states that the 6" water line ends at Walter Tinsley's corner, with a 2" line extending about 1,000 ft, then a 1" and finally 1/2". There were only about three houses on this line when first installed, but the buildings are fast out growing the line. Mayor Lawrence suggests that 6" pipe be diverted from Fairmount Road job to take care of this emergency and replace when new water lines are started. Mr. David suggests Mr. McDaniel figure out just what will be needed and report to next Council meeting.
3. Mr. Wayne Ashworth takes this opportunity to thank Mayor and Aldermen for new water line on "Happy Top" and would appreciate it if the City will curb and pave streets as per petitions. Petition for paving has already been approved at a previous meeting, and will be done as soon as weather will permit. Mayor Lawrence read petition for curbing, starting at Chandler St. including Pisgah Way to Boulevard Heights. (See Attached Petition) Mr. Caldwell makes motion that this curbing be done, seconded by Mr. Woods, voted on and passed.
4. Mr. Oakland Bowen, representing delegation from community above Resaca, Georgia requesting that water line be extended and asked if getting petition signed and money for taps in advance would be of any use. Mayor Lawrence advised that new proposed water project would probably be ready in about three months, and plans were to extend the water lines wherever profitable, and advised Mr. Bowen to have petition presented.
5. Mr. David heard in regard to paving around Swimming pool, and gymnasium. Advises he understands City Board of Education will go 50/50 on this job. Mayor Lawrence advises Mount Alto want Drive way and parking space paved and would be willing to pay City \$ 2,000 to do this work, if did not conflict with private contractors. Mr. David suggests Mr. McDaniel to contact Mr. Boston and check on cost of job and if city will be allowed to do work and report to Council at call meeting Thursday afternoon.
6. Mr. David heard in regard to drainage ditch from Pisgah Way, through property of Mims Harrison, Chetty Moore, and Joe Apperson. New Bond issue is to take care of as much surface drainage as possible. Mayor Lawrence suggests proposition where property owners pay for pipe and City do all the work. Mr. McDaniel to check and report best solution.
7. Mr. Caldwell heard in regard to water leak on North Wall street in front of R. E. Pass. Mr. McDaniel advises this will be repaved as soon as water Department gets to it.
8. Mr. Edwards heard in regard to traffic lights at Court and Wall Sts. Mayor Lawrence advises that parts have arrived and system will be changed as previously agreed upon with a few days.
9. Mr. Thurman Roberts heard in regard to National Guard needing more space. Advises they will change to Armored unit this year and will have about 70 vehicles on the ground, and would appreciate it if the City would donate additional land. Mr. David made motion that City donate land to National Guard Unit from McEnfire street on the North extending east 100 feet from present fence, seconded by Mr. Edwards, voted on and passed.
10. Mr. Edwards heard in regard to fluoridation as fluoridation has already been approved for City. Mayor Lawrence suggests this be added to estimate and installed when new addition to filter plant is built.
11. Mr. McDaniel heard in regard to water for West May Street. Explains that 2,400 feet would service 7 customers and a 2" line would be sufficient. This to be included in new water project.

12. Applications for new Fireman read, but no action taken.

Mr. David made motion to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Edwards, voted on and passed.
