

January 11, 1955

City Council met in regular session, and all members were present.

Mayor Lawrence called the meeting to order and asked that Chief Hayes open with prayer.

1. Mr. David and Mr. Woods were sworn into office, and congratulated by the other members of the council.
2. Minutes of last meeting read and approved.
3. Financial statement of month of December observed, also yearly statement discussed and approved.
4. Mr. David made motion that Mr. McDaniel be reappointed City Engineer, seconded by Mr. Edwards, voted on and passed.
5. Mr. David made motion that H. B. Owen, Sr. be appointed emeritus City Clerk at 60% of present salary, seconded by Mr. Edwards, voted on and passed.
6. Mr. Caldwell made motion that Mr. David be appointed Mayor Protem, seconded by Mr. Edwards, voted on and passed.
7. City Clerk Office open.
8. Mr. Edwards made motion that Sarah Fagala be appointed Acting City Clerk, seconded by Mr. Caldwell, voted on and passed.
9. Mr. Edwards made motion that Mr. Hayes be appointed Police Chief at the salary of \$275.00, and is to have two Sergeants at salary of \$235.00 per month and three Patrolmen at \$220.00 per month. These salaries are to include uniforms. Any new officer starting at \$185.00 for 1st. three months---\$200.00 for second three months then base pay of \$220.00. First Uniform furnished by the City. Mr. Caldwell seconded the motion, voted on and passed.
10. Mr. David made motion that J. W. Holt be appointed water works Operator with J. T. Johnston assisting, seconded by Mr. Edwards, voted on and passed.
11. Mr. Caldwell made motion that Mr. C. F. Lewis be appointed Water & Light Superintendent. Seconded by Mr. David, voted on and passed.
12. Mr. Woods made motion that Mr. Guy Kendrick be appointed Fire Chief, at salary of \$235.00 monthly, with Mr. Charlie Clark and Fred Stephens retained at \$210.00, including uniforms, and new man, Mr. Earl Champion first 3 months at \$185.00--2nd. three months at \$200.00, then base pay of \$210.00,. City to purchase 1st. Uniform. Also 2 weeks extra pay of ~~\$210.00~~ for out-going fireman. Seconded by Mr. Caldwell voted on and passed.
13. Mr. Caldwell made motion that Mr. Kirby be appointed foreman of Street & Garbage Dept.-- Seconded by Mr. Woods, voted on and passed.
14. Mr. Edwards made motion that Mr. Tommie Pope be appointed City Attorney. Seconded by Mr. Caldwell, voted on and passed.
15. Mayor Lawrence appointed Committees-- To remain as last year, with Mr. Woods taking Mr. Nesbitt's place.
16. Mr. Edwards made motion that pay increases as given be retroactive to 1st. of the year, seconded by Mr. Caldwell, voted on and passed.
17. Mayor Lawrence advised that Junior Womans Club have accepted task of renovation of basement of Civic Center. Leak in roof and Water in basement to be taken care of by the City.
18. Mr. David heard in regard to school bus, Advised that Mr. Graves is very well satisfied with Mr. Caylor.

19. Mr. David heard in regard to 2-Way radio. Mr. David to go to Atlanta with statement of authority to sign application with Civil Defense.
20. Mr. David heard in regard to Salute to Calhoun as 2nd. place winner in Better Home Town Contest. States Ballet team will be at City Auditorium Thursday night.
21. Mr. David in regard to Civic Center--Wants some club to take 3rd. floor for library.
22. Mr. Woods in regard to 1½ in. Fire hose. Reports ordered.
23. Mr. Woods heard in regard to painting Garbage truck. This to be taken up with A. B. Richards.
24. Mr. Woods heard in regard to cleaning up yard at City barn. Asks Mr. McDaniel to have men put this material in more orderly shape.
25. Mr. Woods heard in regard to James Baugh Cafe. States he is still not complying with city ordinance. Mr. Woods makes motion that City license be granted all operator except Baugh's cafe, seconded by Mr. Caldwell voted on and passed. Bond & License money to be refunded to James Baugh.
26. Mayor Lawrence heard in regard to monument salesmen in Calhoun.. Suggests that city to send bill for license to any company erecting monument in Calhoun.
27. Mr. David heard in regard to magazine solicitors . Makes motion that soliciting be prohibited. Seconded By Mr. Caldwell, voted on and passed. Local aid Solicitors to be referred to Welfare office.
28. Mr. David makes motion that license for local newspapers be granted as Commercial printers. Seconded by Mr. Caldwell, voted on and passed.
29. Mr. Edwards requests that office of City Clerk be kept open during lunch hour for convenience of people who work.
30. Mayor Lawrence Advises that Mr. C. M. Jones wants water extended to Vetrans Mills. Mr. McDaniel to contact Mr. Jones and see what can be worked out.
31. Mayor Lawrence heard in regard to Insurance on Calhoun Civic Center. Mr. David reports Mr. Starr has policy and will transfer to City.
32. Mr. T. L. Shanahan heard in regard to fleet insurance. Mayor Lawrence suggests that insurance be left as is for year of 1955.
33. Mr. David made motion to adjourn--Seconded by Mr. Caldwell, voted on and passed.
