City council met in regular session with all members present.

Chief Hayes opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and adopted.

Visitors were welcomed to the meeting. Mr. Raymond Goode was present and requested to the council that the city do something to relieve the sewerage situation on McConnel Road near the O'Jay mill. Mr. Goode stated that sewerage was backing up in the houses in that neighborhood. Mayor Lawrence instructed Mr. Goode that the sewerage problem would be taken care of the next day.

Mr. Edwards presented a petition to the council with several names on it stating that they had no objection of Mr. B. A. Yancey getting a beer licenses at the Silver Trolley on the Rome Road. Mayor Lawrence had vetoed a motion that a beer licenses be issued at this place at the previous meeting. After discussion Mayor Lawrence ask for a motion that his veto be overiden but no action was taken.

Mr. Ellis Woods And Mr. Clyde <sup>Yack</sup>~~Floyd~~ of the city of Plainville were present and wanted to know the latest on the water line situation being built to their community. Mr. McDaniel informed them that the City of Plainville would have to write the Southeastern Rating Bureau to find out what size standpipe they would recommend for fire protection. Also after much discussion the mayor stated that he would draw up a contract for each individual water user and the city of Plainville could get started around in the community and see what the reaction would be.

Mr. Otis Garren of Business Men's Assurance Company of America was present and presented a group insurance plan for the city employees. After discussion Mayor Lawrence appointed a committee of Mr. Woods, Mr. David, Mr. Caldwell, and Mr. McDaniel to study the plan and report back at the next meeting.

Mr. David stated that the final payment on the Civil Defense Rescue Truck was due and wanted permission to issue a check in the name of the City for the final payment. This money would be deposited by Mr. David in the City of Calhoun General Fund. After discussion action was delayed until May 1st.

Mr. Dickinson and Mr. Edwards reported that they had talked with Mr. James Beamer about his business licenses and that he had agreed to pay \$ 25.00 on his gin and pay the regular merchant licenses on the other stock at his place of business.


At this time Mr. Edwards made a motion that all employees of the City of Calhoun be paid every two weeks regardless of the date of the month the payments fall on. This motion seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

Mr. Woods stated that he wanted the city park man to police both the parking lots and the city parks.

Mr. Woods also reported that the cemetery committee had purchased a \$ 700.00 mower for the cemetery.

There being no business Mr. David made a motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.
