Calhoun, Georgia

City council met in regular session with all members present.

Mayor Lawrence opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and adopted.

Mr. John Slagle was present to discuss the purchase of a fire truck with the city council. Mayor Lawrence stated that bids on the new truck had been turned in for consideration. After discussion the council decided that a way of financing the new truck must be worked out before the bids could be considered. Mr. Tom David and Mr. Slagle agreed to hold a meeting at 3:30 PM on June 11th to work out details on financing the new truck. There were no bids on the truck read at this meeting.

Mr. Neal Sutherland was present and explained that he had received a notice that his special licenses for operating a taxi service in the city were due. Mr. Sutherland stated that he was under the impression that disabled veterans received a free license in the city. After discussion Mr. David made a motion that all disabled veterans in the City of Calhoun be granted a license without payment of a fee as required by the city license ordinance. This motion seconded by Mr. Dickinson. Mayor Lawrence called for a vote on the motion and Mr. David, Mr. Woods, and Mr. Dickinson voted aye with Mr. Edwards voting nay. *MR. EDWARDS OPPOSES VETERANS DRAWING COMPENSATION*

Mr. Dickinson made a motion that Mr. J.H. Hobgood, Mr. Beverly Langford and Mr. Jack Boston be appointed to represent the city on the City-County Planning Commission. This motion seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.

Mr. Edwards stated that he would like to see the driveways in the city fixed as soon as possible. Mr. Edwards also stated that he wanted the city to stop parking on both sides of Piedmont Street from Hicks to South Wall. After discussion Mr. Edwards made a motion that parking be stop on the East side of Piedmont Street from the intersection of Hicks to the intersection of South Wall. This motion seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

Mr. Woods requested that the council give the local radio station WCGA permission to move its station from the present Court Street address to the Myron's Restaurant Building on South Wall Street. This permission granted.

Mayor Lawrence stated that Mr. J. W. Holt had requested that his salary be raised due to the fact that he was having to use his car to check the new water tank. After discussion Mayor Lawrence turned the matter over to Mr. Hoyt Edwards chairman of the water and light committee.

Mayor Lawrence stated that Mr. Jake Barton on College Street wanted his driveway fixed. He appointed Mr. Frank Dickinson chairman of the street committee to look into the matter.

City Clerk Calvin Caldwell requested that the pay of Mrs. H. B. Owen Jr be raised to \$40.00 per week. Mr. Edwards made a motion that this be put into effect seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

There being no other business Mr. Dickinson made a motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.
