Calhoun, Georgia

City Council met in regular session at the City Hall with all members present.

Mayor Lawrence opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and adopted.

City Attorney John Gregory was present and stated to the council that Sudie Clark had brought a petition against the City of Calhoun and Aycock Construction Company and restrained them from doing any work on her property on Line Street. Sudie claimed that the city wasn't doing the work as they should. A hearing was to be held before Judge Mitchell on Saturday February 2, 1957 at 10 am.

Mayor Lawrence expressed his appreciation to Mr. Tom B. David for the work and plans he had made as Civil Defense Director. Mr. David had worked out a complete plan for the city in case of an enemy attack.

Mr. David reported that Mr. Gene Moss had requested that the City build a sidewalk from the present Housing Project sidewalk on Neal street down to the street level. No action taken.

Mr. Dickinson reported that Mr. Royal Teague of Teague's Style Shop wanted permission to extend the front of his building out on the sidewalk about three inches. Council agreed to grant this permission.

The council at this time agreed to give the piano at the Civic Center to the Calhoun Junior Woman's club.

Mr. Woods reported that a lot of paper and trash was on the ground near the baseball park fence. Instructed the Police Dept. to use some of their prisoners to clean this place up.

Mr. Edwards reported that he had reports that the pool room was staying open after 11 pm which was in violation of the pool room ordinance. Mr. Edwards instructed the police to inform Mr. Phillips to obey the ordinance or the council would have to take some kind of action against him.

Mr. David reports that the city can purchase the Pat Logan lot which is 65 X 65 located on Fair Street for the some of \$1,000.00. After discussion Mr. David made a motion that the city purchase this lot for the some of \$ 1,000.00 to be paid 1/3 down the first year 1/3 down the second year and 1/3 down the third year which Mr. Logan had agreed to payments this way. No second to this motion. After discussion Mr. Dickinson made a motion to table Mr. David's motion seconded by Mr. Edwards voted on and passed.

Mr. Edwards stated that Mr. Charlie Barrett wanted water in his two houses on the Old Dalton Road which would require an extension of approximately 292 feet. After discussion Mr. Edwards made a motion to extend the water line to the Barrett property. No second to the motion. After more discussion Mr. Edwards made a motion to extend the water line to the houses and require Mr. Barrett to install two meters and to pay the two minimums. Seconded by Mr. Woods voted on and passed.

At this time Mr. Edwards made a motion to accept the additional South-eastern Power Administration contract which was to allott the City of Calhoun additional Power under the original contract. Seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

There being no other business Mr. David made a motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. Woods voted on and passed.
