

December 9, 1957
Calhoun, Georgia

City Council met in regular session at the City Hall with all members present.

Alderman Frank Dickinson opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

Mr. Tom David stated to the council that the Calhoun CD Truck had been used in hunting two drowned men in the Etowah River near Cartersville, Georgia and that some expense had built up during the period. The council agreed that the city would pay this expense and any other expense that might occur in the use of the truck in the future.

Mr. Frank Dickinson made a motion all city employees be given the same Christmas Bonus as they received in 1956. This being one fourth of the monthly salaries for all dept. heads and twenty five dollars for all other employees. This motion was seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.

Mr. Wood made a motion that an ordinance be drawn up to stop trespassing on the land owned by the city and used for a city dump. This would include anyone gathering paper or articles of any description. This motion was seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

Council agreed to paint a crosswalk diagonally across from Evan's Dept. Store to the Martin Theatre.

Mr. David made a motion that a warranty deed for the streets in the Valley View Subdivision from the Roy D. Warren Company be accepted by the City of Calhoun at this time. This seconded by Mr. Edwards voted on and passed.

Mr. David made a motion that \$500.00 be transferred from the general fund of the City of Calhoun to the City-County Planning Commission fund for the purpose of paying the expenses of the Commission. This motion seconded by Mr. Edwards voted on and passed.

Mr. David made a motion that the garbage truck be painted seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

City Council Agreed that the 25th and 26th of December would be observed as Christmas Holidays. The Clerk's office would be closed on these dates.

There being no other business Mr. Dickinson made a motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. Woods voted on and passed.
