City Council Met in regular session with all members present.

The meeting was opened by prayer by Alderman Frank Dickinson.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and adopted.

Mr. C. M. Hatton of the Gulf Oil Company was present and requested that the City allow him to tap on to the City Sewerage line on South Wall Street at the Howard Gravitt Service Station. Mr. Hatton stated that he had built a new station and installed a septic tank but was having trouble with the drainage. There was some discussion since the station property was outside the city limits. After discussion Mr. David made a motion that Gulf Oil Company be permitted to tap into the city sewerage line with a monthly charge to be set later. This charge to be waived at the present. This motion seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

Mr. J. M. MUSE and a delegation from the City of Sugar Valley were present to discuss the progress made in running water to their city. Mr. Muse stated that they had 80 customers plus the \$150.00 per month guarantee from the J. M. Muse Corporation signed to take water. This would allow the City of Calhoun to borrow approximately \$62,000.00 on the line. The approximate cost was \$75,000.00. After much discussion and figuring the delegation decided to try and get the need additional customers signed at an early date.

Mr. Marvin Taylor and Mr. Ellis Woods of the City of Plainville were present to discuss the progress made in obtaining water for their city. Mr. Taylor stated that they had 122 customers signed. This included no schools or large business houses. After figuring the cost of the line it was decided that approximately 40 more customers were needed to make the line a paying proposition. The delegation stated they would try and obtain the needed additional customers.

Mr. Pat Patterson and a representative from the Lincoln National Life Ins. Co. were present to discuss a new group plan for the city but after discussion no action was taken.

Mr. J. W. Holt was present and requested that the council pay him for the use of his car in checking the water tanks and the pump on Victory Drive. After discussion the council decided to let Mr. Lewis take care of the tanks. Mr. Holt would be contacted at a later date about the car expense for the last year..

Mr. J. H. Harrell and Mr. Young of the Gulf Life Ins. Co. were present and discussed a new group plan for the city employees. No action taken.

Mr. David stated that the mayor and council were invited to a meeting at Mrs. Billy Norton's on Saturday June 29th at 7PM. The meeting was for the purpose of discussing a recreation director for the city on a full time basis. Mayor Lawrence appointed the recreation committee to attend.

The council agreed to stagger the terms of the members of the City-County Planning Commission. The terms were as follows J.H. Boston, 1 year, J.H. Hobgood, 3 years, Beverly Langford, 3 years.

Mr. David ask permission from the council to purchase a first aid kit in the amount of \$150.00 for Civil Defense purposes. Councils OK's.

Mayor Lawrence wanted to go on record as commending Mr. Tom David for the fine job he was doing as Civil Defense Director.

Mr. Woods ask to go on record as appreciating the help the Calhoun Police Force put forth in trying to locate his father in the death of Mr. Bud Shugart.

There being no other business Mr. Dickinson made motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.
