City Council met in regular session with all members present except Mr. Woods who was absent because of sickness.

Mr. Dickinson opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk and adopted by the council.

Alderman David stated to the council that a show man with some show horses wanted the Civil Defense Department to sponsor a show but he had advised against it. The Council was in agreement with Mr. David.

Mayor Lawrence appointed Mr. Edwards, Mr. Dickinson, and Mr. David to go to the property owners on Line Street and see what could be worked out to fix their property.

A change in the city charter to set up a recorder's court was discussed by the council. After discussion Mr. David made a motion that the city charter be amended to change the Mayor's Court to a Recorder's Court with the provision that the mayor and council have authority for appointing and setting salary of said recorder. This amendment to be introduced in the State Legislature in Jan. of 1958. This motion seconded by Mr. Edwards voted on and passed.

Installing of Christmas lights discussed. Council thought the week of Thanksgiving was good time to put lights up. Instructed City Engineer to install the week of Thanksgiving. Mayor Lawrence appointed Alderman Dickinson Chairman of the Christmas Tree and Street Decoration.

There being no other business the Council was adjourned. Mr. David made the motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.
