

1. Invocation given by Ald. Padgett.
2. Minutes read and correction made on sending letter to Department of Transportation.
3. Mr. B. J. Bell discussed clean up campaign and land use plan.
4. Clerk instructed to write letters to owners of property giving them 30 days to clean up.
5. Mr. Moore requested a zoning variance. Mayor recommended he contact Board of Appeals.
6. Mr. Joe Hunt described the duties he could perform for the City in land use management and solid waste management. Mayor referred this to committee.
7. Motion to dispense with first reading of Ordinance pertaining to Occupation Tax for Bell Telephone by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Padgett, carried. Motion to adopt ordinance by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Padgett. Carried.
8. Mr. B.J. Bell stated approximate cost of area beautification \$3,000. Mayor recommended that the local garden club be contacted.
9. Motion by Ald. Collins to use voting machines and absentee ballots, 2nd by Ald. Padgett. Carried.
10. Street lighting discussed by Ald. Collins. Jack Bell to check with Police Department on security and report back to the council, he is also to check on corridor rights.
11. Roy Fox reported Dog Pound now open.
12. Court Street and West Side Project discussed.
13. Ald Padgett asked about sewerage for Mr. Lovingood. Roy Fox reported Mr. Lovingood would pay for installation, if City charged no sewerage charge for 10 years.
14. Ald. Padgett asked if any Federal Funds were available for McConnell Road. Mr. B. J. Bell and Roy Fox reported no Federal Funds available.
15. Annual Coosa Valley Bill brought up, no action taken.
16. Petitions for annexation of F. D. Duffey, Nora Bell Barnette, Billy R. Baxter and Roy P. Varner and John L. Varner and William Bledsoe read. Motion to accept as of Jan. 1, 1974, by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Padgett. Carried.
17. Roy Fox reported application to Federal Government increasing their share of expanded sewerage cost has been turned in.
18. Roy Fox reported Mr. McDaniel anticipates a finishing plant in 14 to 16 months. Approximate consumption of 6,000,000 gallons of water per month. Mayor authorized to write letter of intent to supply water. Roy Fox to compile figures for expansion of water system.
19. James Owens requested a 2" water tap. Approved.
20. Motion to adjourn by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Collins. Done.
