

NOVEMBER 12, 1973 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT
EXCEPT ALD. GEORGE COX.

1. Invocation given by Ald. Mathews.
2. Minutes read and approved.
3. Ben Morrow requested a change in location of his retail business. Referred to Ald. Padgett and the Police Chief.
4. Model Resolution pertaining to flood insurance discussed. Motion to dispense with first reading by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Padgett, carried. Motion to adopt flood insurance ordinances by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Padgett, carried.
5. The following appointments were made for the municipal election to be held November 21, 1973:
Chief Manager Hoyt Edwards; Assistant Manager Buddy Autry; Assistant Manager Ashley Sandrock; Voting Machine Custodian Buddy Autry. Buddy Autry designated to have control of keys. Chief Registrar Hoyt Edwards, Assistant Registrar Ashley Sandrock; Absentee Ballot Clerk Ashley Sandrock; Clerk Will Nell Mobley; Clerk Jimmy Black.
Motion to approve by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Collins, Carried.
6. Petition of Mrs. Curtis on Highway 53 for annexation brought up by Roy Fox. Motion to accept by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Mathews. Carried. Effective Jan. 1, 1974.
7. Council expressed their desire to have the city participate in the annual motorcade to Central State Hospital on Dec. 12, 1973.
8. Council agreed to the city having Christmas lights after Jack Bell explained that no significant power usage would result.
9. Water taps for Dean Hayes and Paul Pendley were approved on a motion by Ald. Padgett and 2nd by Ald. Collins, carried.
10. Fire Chief brought up the need for a utility vehicle for the Fire Department. Referred to Ald. Mathews and Hoyt Edwards.
11. Motion to adjourn by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Padgett. Done
