

1. Rev. Henry E. Holland delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Jan. 8 meeting read and approved.
3. Mrs. John (Ginny) Reese introduced Mrs. Holland of the Voluntary Action Center, who asked permission to hold a sale at the old school on College St. on Saturday, May 5. Request granted on motion of Ald. Mathews and Cox.
4. Joseph W. "Beebe" Hobgood, dba A & W Drive In, asked permission to park a mobile home on his lot for 6 months. Ald. Padgett made the motion to allow this, Ald. Collins seconded and the motion was duly passed.
5. Tom Curtis said he'd like to know when the city plans to extend sanitary sewer service on Peters St. Asst. Supt. Fox and Ald. Padgett both responded, but neither promised any service for the near future.
6. Ald. Cox moved to grant Ben D. Morrow a liquor license at a Fairmount Road address adjoining the Minit King Food Market. Ald. Collins seconded and the motion was approved.
7. Application for a liquor license of John L. Ray at a new location on 736 N. Wall St. read with a public hearing scheduled Feb. 12.
8. Ald. Cox heard in regard to bids on a police car not acted on at the last meeting and made a motion to accept the low bid of Roy Davis Chevrolet-Olds, \$3,823.24. (Prater Ford's bid was 3,847.00). Ald. Collins 2nd the motion and it was voted on and passed.
9. Ald. Cox said Merrill Dobbs and the other owners of Gordon Hills Shopping Center wished to place a concession stand trailer in the center in front of the Piggly Wiggly. Ald. Mathews moved to permit this installation provided a state permit is obtained, 2nd by Ald. Cox and passed.
10. Ald. Mathews moved the adoption of the forced account resolution with the Department of Transportation on SR 156 in the amount of \$12,564.44; 2nd by Ald. Padgett and approved.
11. Ald. Cox suggested and Council agreed to advertise the old fire truck for sale with the old police car.
12. Asst. Supt. Fox said John Wayne Hall had offered the lot the city now leases on the Sugar Valley Road in exchange for extending water to his subdivision. Council accepted on motion of Ald. Padgett and Mathews.
13. Clerk gave a brief report on the Power Section meeting in Atlanta on Sunday, Jan. 14 and advised that the next meeting is slated for Atlanta on Thursday, Jan. 25.
14. Elec. Supt. Bell asked for an explanation of the business license ordinance pertaining to contractors. Following discussion, Ald. Collins explained this section of the ordinance.
15. Water & Sewer Supt. Bowman reported that he had five water taps approved by the committee and they were ok'd by the Council on motion of Ald. Padgett and Collins.
16. Ald. Collins moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Cox and done.
