

MARCH 26, 1973-REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

1. Rev. Jack Lamb, pastor of the First United Methodist Church delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the March 12 meeting read and approved.
3. Rev. Jack Lamb requested traffic light at intersection of College and East Line streets. Council instructed city manager to contact Department of Transportation.
4. Rev. Jack Lamb requested one-way of College between Trammell and Line Streets it was discussed and Ald. Mathews to see residents.
5. Letter from Kayo Oil Company offering \$125.00 per month to renew lease at W. Line and River for two 5 year periods. Ald. Collins moved to lease for one cent per gallon, per month. Second by Ald. Cox and passed.
6. Sgt. Charles Mims present, Mayor introduced him to all present.
7. Clerk read application for package malt beverage license of George E. Calfee for Minit Market at 406 N. Wall St, referred to Ald. Cox.
8. Ald. Cox moved to grant Ben D. Morrow package beer license on SR 53, 2nd by Ald. Collins, voted and passed.
9. Ald. Padgett moved to issue no more license until Jan. 1, 1974 or later, tabled.
10. Ald. Collins asked clerk to collect grave opening fee from funeral directors.
11. Ald. Padgett heard on re-routing traffic to South River St. to SR 53 to alleviate traffic on South Wall Street.
12. Clerk reported Raymond King said architect was going to show how to stop corrosion of bank at Gordon Hills Shopping Center.
13. Ald. Padgett said \$6,000 to catalog water value locations and requested council approval to employ Williams, Sweitzer and Barnum to do this. 2nd by Ald. Mathews and passed.
14. Asst. Supt. Fox said contractor on Antioch tank would complete in 60 days.
15. Ald. Padgett moved approval of seven water taps. 2nd by Ald. Cox and passed.
16. Ald. Collins moved adopting of resolution of naming Charles Mims citizen of the week for attending meeting while on leave.
17. Electric Supt. Bell warned anyone needing electrical equipment should order months ahead of date of need.
18. James Owens suggested having architect look at old school building to determine if it should be remodeled.
19. Ald. Cox requested for transportation for fire department to use police car.
20. Ald. Padgett moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Cox and done.
