

FEB. 26, 1973 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.


1. Ald. Mathews delivered the invocation.
2. Mrs. Tom (Kay) Pope briefed the Council on plans for the Day Care Center, advised that they will soon have 21 children enrolled and invited the Council to come by and visit with them. Mrs. Pope advised that the school authorities had given the swings and other playground equipment to the center. Mrs. Pope said that this equipment will have to be moved within the fenced area before they ~~can~~ can use it. The Council promised to have this done.
3. The Dept. of Family and Children's Service requested Mayor Dickinson to declare May as Senior Citizens' Month. Council adopted a resolution on motion of Ald. Padgett and Cox.
4. Council approved a liquor license at 736 N. Wall St. for John L. Ray, Jr. following motion of Ald. Collins, 2nd of Ald. Cox.
5. Ald. Mathews stated that he believed a moratorium on liquor licenses was in order and moved that no more be issued until Jan. 1, 1974; 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.
6. Ald. Collins recommended that Elec. Inspector Bell check all electrical signs on or near a sidewalk to be certain that they are properly grounded.
7. Supt. Owens estimated the cost of extending sanitary sewer service to the Mary Johnson farm, (proposed new location for Venture Carpet), at \$15,000.00. Ald. Padgett moved to make this extension provided it is annexed to the city, 2nd by Ald. Cox and passed.
8. Ald. Collins moved to permit the Gordon County Farm Bureau to use a mobile home for an office on S. Wall St. for 6 months. Ald. Mathews seconded and the motion was approved.
9. Ald. Padgett moved to approve 2 water taps, 2nd by Ald. Cox and passed.
10. Water Supt. Bowman estimated it will cost \$2,600.00 to extend an 8" water main to Scoggins-McBrayer Furniture for a sprinkler tap. Council to negotiate with Mr. Scoggins.
11. Council postponed action on package beer licenses for grocers.
12. Ald. Mathews suggested that the Council, the 4 liquor licensees, and representatives from the American Legion and the V. F. W. meet at 5 PM, Friday, March 9 at City Hall. Council agreed.
13. Ald. Padgett moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Cox and done.
