 - f. Ordinance pertaining to parking on a section of Piedmont St. Motion by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Cox, carried.
 - g. Ordinance to amend gas code. Motion by Ald. Cox, 2nd by Ald. Collins, carried.
5. Rabies control ordinance referred to next council meeting.
6. Jack Bell presented Mr. Ray D. Cohn of Southeastern Consulting Engineers. Mr. Cohn presented a proposal to study rates for electric, water and sewerage. The study to cost \$7650.00. Motion by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Padgett, carried.
7. James Owens requested information on annexing Venture and Goodyear. Proposal discussed. No action.
8. Ald. Padgett brought up extended vacation for employees with service of 10 years or more. Clerk to check with companies in this area and report back at next council meeting.
9. Ald. Padgett brought up cost of water taps. To be discussed at next council meeting.
10. Mayor asked for motion to lower qualifying ages, in city elections, from 25 to 21. Asked for motion 3 times. No Action.
11. Roy Fox discussed using Joe Hunt as a consultant for the landfill. Roy understands the County has employed Mr. Hunt. Referred to Ted Collins, Roy Fox, Hoyt Edwards to contact Everett DeFoor.
12. Roy Fox reported the sewer line into the Daisy and White street areas would serve 20 customers. Roy also recommended a fence be built around the city maintenance shops. Council agreed and granted authority to proceed in the least costly fashion.
13. Petitions for annexation of Melvin Dobson and Gene Holbrook heard. Motion by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Cox, carried. Plats and deeds needed. Effective date 1973 if the city can collect the 1973 taxes. if the city cannot collect the 1973 taxes, the
