

MAY 28, 1973 - REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT
EXCEPT ALD. BILL MATHEWS.

1. Invocation given by Frank Dickinson.
2. Minutes of May 14 and May 22, 1973, meetings of the City Council read and accepted.
3. City School Board presented their proposed operating budget for fiscal year 7/1/73 to 6/30/74 of \$434,379. Motion by Ald. Collins 2nd by Ald. Cox to accept budget. Carried.
4. City School Board recommended a bond issue of \$225,000. To provide for additional classrooms; a new band room; repairs at the Line Street gymnasium; a new roof, dressing rooms and repairs to the bathrooms at the Junior High School; air condition the balance of the High School; paint and air condition the old school. Motion to issue bonds made by Ald. Billy Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Cox. Carried.
5. Ald. Cox commended the city employees for their fine effort expended to restore power and clear streets during the storm.
6. Ald. Collins brought up decibel meter. City Clerk to check.
7. Hoyt Edwards reported on hearing to be set in August on Spring Valley Subdivision. GMA is going to assist the city, at least through the hearing, in the person of Cliff Adams. County Judge approved the city connecting electricity to Spring Valley Subdivision pending final disposition of NGEMC's injunction.
8. Roy Fox brought up hanger rental being paid to City, there is no liability on the city to aircraft owners renting space.
9. Roy Fox recommended a fee of \$25.00 for insurance companies in checking fire hydrants. Motion by Ald. Cox, 2nd by Ald. Collins. Carried.
10. Roy Fox brought up easement across the property of Tom Champion. City Council authorized a maximum of \$1600.00
11. Price of \$686.00 quoted for repairing roof at the City Maintenance Department, and the roof on the rear portion of City Hall. Motion by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Cox. Quote accepted.
12. Paving of Court Street # 1 priority for state aid paving, Referred to State for approval.
13. Motion by Ald. Padgett to approve 1 water tap, 2nd by Ald. Cox, Carried.
14. Fire Chief Grizzle recommended adoption of National Fire Codes dated 1972 - 1973, published by the National Fire Protection Association. Motion by Ald. Cox, 2nd by Ald. Collins to adopt. Carried.
15. Two appeals from City Court were heard with Mayor protem George Cox presiding. Case # 450 Wade Stephens, motion by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Padgett to uphold verdict. Carried.
Case # 479 Barry K. Hobgood, motion by Ald. Collins, 2nd. by Ald. Padgett to uphold verdict. Carried.
