

1. Invocation given by Rev. John Allen.
2. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.
3. A group of citizens from Adair Street, Fox Subdivision appeared before the council. Hoyt Edwards reported that a 2" water line was to be installed. Anticipated start date of Sept. 25, 1973.
4. Health and sanitation concern of the citizens of Adair Street Fox Subdivision expressed. Mayor Dickinson said he would do all he could, if the inhabitants would vote favorably on a referendum for annexation into the city.
5. Ald. Collins and Roy Fox met with Joe Hunt. Mr. Hunt's services include setting up solid waste management, aid in obtaining funds from Federal and State Agencies. Mr. Hunt's proposal discussed. Referred to the Mayor, Roy Fox for further discussion with Everett Defoor.
6. Raw sewage problem in open ditch between the Railroad and Pisgah Way discussed, approximately 900 ft. under discussion. Estimated cost of \$10,000.00 to eliminate raw sewage problem. Motion by Ald. Collins to proceed, 2nd by Ald. Mathews. Carried.
7. Ald. Collins brought up employees uniforms. Discussion followed, Hoyt Edwards to check with rental company with regard to deposits and returns of rented uniforms.
8. Ald. Mathews brought up the need for street signs at the First United Methodist Church cautioning motorists of children playing, also the need for no littering signs close to the church. The council instructed Slim Kirby to have these signs erected.
9. Ald. Padgett brought up cost of water taps, he made a motion that 3/4" tap fee for water should be \$125.00 inside and outside, and 2" taps should be \$375.00 inside and outside, 2nd by Ald. Mathews. Carried. These rates effective October 1, 1973.
10. Milton Stewart requested permission to place a house trailer behind Gordon County Building Supply. Motion by Ald. Collins to allow for six months, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, carried.
11. Mr. Sitton's problem in conjunction with Mr. Tomlinson presented to the council. Council agreed to uphold the City's records.
12. Resolution to appoint Roy Fox as the City's authorized representative to sign estimates for HUD Project Ga N-28 approved by the Council.
13. The Clerk and Mayor were authorized to establish a \$80,000.00 open line of credit for loans as needed.
14. Letter from Georgia Municipal Association discussed. Council recommends a pro rata share of costs for the 7th District fall meeting. Clerk to send letter.
15. The council moved to dispense with the reading and adopt the following ordinances.

- a. Rabies Control. Motion by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Mathews. Carried.
 - b. Regulating and Levying License Fees and Taxes for Insurance Businesses. Motion by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Padgett, Carried.
 - c. Southern Standard Building Code. Motion by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Mathews. Carried.
 - d. Electric Work, Inside City. Motion by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Collins. Carried.
16. Petition by Wallace Bryant for annexation read. Motion by Ald. Collins to accept, if the City can collect the 1973 taxes if not the effective date should be Jan. 1, 1974, 2nd by Ald. Mathews. Carried.
 17. The widening of Pisgah Way and Stone Haven was discussed, also curbs, gutter and storm drains. Referred to Hoyt Edwards and Roy Fox.
 18. Hoyt Edwards instructed to contact School Board and give them 30 days to remove any equipment they have stored in the old College Street School, as it is to be demolished.
 19. Roy Fox brought up Sprinkler Problem at the Hospital. The Hospital needs 300 ft. of 8 inch pipe plus the tap. The County will supply the labor and equipment for this project. Motion by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Padgett to approve. Carried.
 20. Bruce Bowman announced the interceptor on the south end (industrial park) to be hooked up on Sept. 25, 1973.
 21. Motion by Ald. Collins to adjourn and 2nd by Ald. Padgett. Done.
