

1. Invocation delivered by Ald. Mathews.
2. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.
3. Mrs. ~~John L.~~ Reese requested that funds for Calhoun - Gordon County Animal Shelter be sent to City Hall c/o Kathie Phillips. Motion by Ald. Mathews seconded by Ald. Padgett. The clerk to check with Merrill Dobbs. Passed.
4. Mrs. ~~McGinty~~ ^{REESE} announced that of eleven National Water Safety awards Calhoun is to receive one of six within the south. She thanked the Council for their cooperation in the water safety program.
5. Mrs. Peggy Wharton brought before the Council the following:
 - a. To build the building promised for the Black Civic Club after the old Stephens High School Building was condemned. This community building will be for the public.
 - b. To place lights and benches at the Line Street School track field.
 - c. To cover the drainage ditch on Court Street.
 - d. To pave Court Street with asphalt instead of gravel and tar. Motion by Ald. Collins 2nd by Ald. Cox to turn over to Hoyt Edwards for cost estimate for next council meeting.
6. Traffic light application for intersection of 53 and 41 to be sent in to the state. Approximate cost \$12,000 to \$14,000. The county will participate in one-half of the cost. Motion to approve by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Billy Padgett. Passed.
7. Fire hydrants needed at Sherwood and Devonwood Subdivisions. Referred to Hoyt Edwards for cost estimate.
8. Roy Fox said the new sewage plant contractor has his men on job correcting problems. No cost to City as the new plant is still the contractors responsibility.
9. Possible increase in deposits and cut off charges referred to Ald. Padgett and Mathews for proposals.
10. Check prior minutes for City to acquire street from Dr. J. A. Bishop.
11. Hoyt Edwards brought up relief of building fees for Raymond King on three buildings. No action fees stand as they are.
12. Eleven water taps approved. Motion by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Mathews. Passed.
13. Hoyt Edwards to meet with Howard Holbert on the Marathon Station and report back to the Council.
14. Kayo Oil Co. resubmitted their request on renting the station at West Line Street and River Street for \$.01 per gallon with a minimum of \$125.00 and a maximum of \$250.00 per month. Motion by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Cox. Passed.
15. Roy Fox reported he is receiving bids for painting and other maintenance work at City Hall. Motion by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Padgett to accept low bid for painting exterior, when 3 bids are received. Passed.
