

1. Mayor Burdette delivered invocation.
2. Minutes of July 22, 1974, meeting read and approved.
3. Mayor Burdette discussed problem of young people congregating at Gordon Hills Shopping Center, Roy Davis Chevrolet-Olds and one or two other areas in the evenings, making loud noises and causing disturbance. Mayor has instructed Chief of Police to make arrests on charges of loitering. Mayor also requests help of parents to control this situation.
4. Harold Faith presented petition with 171 signatures for annexation to City in area between Highway 53 and Dews Pond Road on the east side of City. City officials will explore possibility of Federal assistance in providing services such as sewer, fire protection and school facilities.
5. Harry Smith made complaint of junk yard at Jerry Davis location 1240 US 41 North. Mayor suggested Police check out frequently next two weeks to stop noise and disturbance during night hours.
6. David Smith, C & S Garbage Service, Dalton, asked permission of Council to submit proposal for sanitation service to City of Calhoun. Mayor appointed Hoyt Edwards to work with Mr. Smith in making proposal.
7. Herbert King, representing First Baptist Church, asked status of College Street School property. Special Council meeting called for 6 p.m. Monday, Aug. 19, 1974, to discuss this property and make definite decision if possible.
8. Motion by Ald. Lewis, 2nd by Ald. Collins to permit Ray's Package Store to relocate from 736 N. Wall St. to 900 N. Wall St., motion approved.
9. Problem of surface water and ditch on King Street near High School. Proposal made to install 36" pipe in this area. Also Woods property, Beamer barn property and College St. School property be cleaned up.
10. Bids opened for new car for Police Chief. Prater Ford offered bid of \$3997.00 on 1974 Ford Gran Torino, Prater Ford also bid \$3839.00 on 1974 Torino 4 door sedan. Roy Davis Chevrolet-Olds bid \$3514.11 on Chevelle Malibu. Motion by Ald. Lewis, 2nd by Ald. Collins to accept low bid of \$3514.11 on Chevelle Malibu.
11. Roy Fox reported that due to rain the past week Joe Hunt did not come and landfill status remains the same.
12. Motion by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Lewis to approve water taps for Mrs. Harmon, 310 Peters St., Mrs. McDearis, 312 Peters St. and Grady Duvall, New Town Road.
13. Discussion on new water minimums for customers outside city limits -- no action taken.

16. Hoyt Edwards advised City School Board needs funds. Mr. Edwards to check with Mr. Cate as to amount needed so payment can be made.
17. Motion by Ald. Mathews to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Collins, approved.
