

1. Invocation given by Bill Jones.
2. Minutes read and approved.
3. Mr. Skidmore of Coosa Valley presented a plan for a shared Traffic Engineer. Cost to Coosa Valley \$33,000,  $\frac{1}{2}$  to be paid by the State, cost to Calhoun for 20% of his time \$3,000. He requested letter of intent. Discussion followed, motion to table by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Lewis, carried. (To be brought up at next meeting.)
4. Mayor asked Chief Hayes about quarantine of dogs. This is to be publized in March and done in the first two weeks of April.
5. Releasing of dogs discussed. Mayor requested increased police patrols and Roy Fox to investigate solution.
6. Amended recreation by laws brought up. Motion to dispense with 1st and 2nd reading and adopted by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, carried.
7. Ordinance to Prohibit the consumption of Alcoholic Beverages by minors in the City was brought up and read. Motion to dispense with 2nd reading and adopt by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Lewis, carried.
8. Lot at rear of Post Office brought up by Ald. Mathews. Mr. Chance would allow to use for parking, and for City to black top. Referred to Hoyt Edwards for report on cost.
9. Proposed uniform policy discussed. Motion to approve retro-active to Jan. 1, 1973, by Ald. Lewis, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, carried.
10. Police Insurance discussed throught the National Sheriffs Association. Clerk authorized to renew on a motion by Ald. Lewis 2nd by Ald. Padgett, carried.
11. Ald. Padgett made a motion to approve two water taps (for Michael Rice and M. B. Millwood), 2nd by Ald. Mathews, carried.
12. Mayor brought up Victory Drive. Discussion followed with Mr. Dobbs and the Council. Motion by Ald. Lewis for Wall Street Investment to purchase right of way and the City would pay for rerouting the street, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, carried.
13. New property for land fill discussed.
14. Roy Fox recommended the purchase of a used dirt pan, approximate cost of \$400.00. Motion to approve by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Padgett, carried.
15. Roy Fox read two petitions for annexation for Mr. W. G. Robertson and E. W. Collins. Motion by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Padgett. carried.
16. Carolina Freight's Mr. Cook had spoken with Roy Fox on sewer, Mr. Cook requested an agreement be worked out with the City on possible rebates. Referred to Roy Fox.
17. Hoyt Edwards reported on trip to Court on Power Suit - too soon to tell.
18. Ald. Collins requested a study on removing downtown meters and chalking tires. Referred to Roy Fox, Hoyt Edwards, Chief Hayes.
