


1. Invocation given by Rev. John Allen.
2. Minutes read and approved.
3. Steve Pishke of Arch Roberts Securities came before the Council and presented final form of reissuance of bonds. Tom Shanahan said he saw no legal objection. Motion to accept by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, carried.
4. David Hodgins requested a 6 month permit to park a trailer at Preferred Tuck Leasing Co. Motion by Ald. Mathews to approve 2nd by Ald. Padgett, carried.
5. Highway Engineer Proposal of Coosa Valley tabled on a motion by Ald. Lewis, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, carried.
6. Car parking at rear of Post Office discussed. Property to be obtained for 2 years. Approximate cost of plant mix \$1600 for 13 parking spaces.
7. Wall Street Investment has paid for the right of way for Mrs. Bishop's property.
8. Sewerage at Carolina Freight discussed. No action ^{NEED} estimate and contract to act upon. To be brought up at next meeting.
9. The subject of ^{PARKING} meters being by passed on Court St. discussed.
10. Court Street Parking discussed. Results still good. Discussion followed. Ald. Mathews recommended one hour parking (on Court St.), 2nd by Ald. Lewis, carried.
11. No blocking of intersection at Calhoun First National Bank to be allowed.
12. Littering discussed -- signs to be erected.
13. Rezoning of 3 acres on South side of Pine Street to be advertised.
14. Ald. Mathews recommended the purchase of a \$700 utility vehicle for Civil Defense. Federal Government to pay for 1/2 of maintenance, 2nd by Ald. Lewis, carried.
15. Council instructed the street dept. to clear off the vacant lot at Briarwood.
16. Seven water taps recommended to be approved by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, carried.
17. Motion to adjourn by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Mathews and done.
