

1. Rev. John Allen, Belmont Baptist Church, gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of Aug. 12 meeting read and approved. Minutes of special meeting of Aug. 19 read and approved.
3. The Mayor brought up matter of College Street School property but due to receiving only one appraisal, discussion would be postponed. However, a number of interested residents were in attendance and discussion continued. It was decided to call a special meeting for 7:30 p.m. Wednesday, Sept. 4, to bring this matter to a conclusion.
4. First reading of retail beer license application for Big 5 Restaurant by O.L. Hilgeman.
5. Petition was read for installation of street light at intersection of Normandy and Devonwood Drive. Jack Bell to check.
6. Mike David, who has a six month permit for trailer on Oothcaloga Street behind the Country Kitchen, requested an additional six months. Motion by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, motion approved.
7. Mrs. Susie Hagwood made complaint of shooting of dogs by W. J. Gazaway. Mrs. Hagwood was advised to call Police.
8. Petitions to annex properties of W. G. (Bill) Robertson and E. W. Collins at intersection of I-75 and Highway 53 were read. Motion by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Mathews to dispense with first reading of petitions and accept reading. Motion approved.
9. Letter from Associated Medical Group, Decatur, Ala., requesting information as to future need of medical clinic in Calhoun. Letter given to Hoyt Edwards to check with Chamber of Commerce.
10. Petition of Ernest Ralston read proposing change in zoning of property on Oothcaloga St. now zoned Industrial G, Residential 2 and Commercial 2. Mr. Gene Latham representing Petrolane Gas Service requested information as to the effect proposed zoning change would have on their operation as they have a lease for a portion of this property. Motion by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Lewis that proposed change be denied and present zoning be continued. Motion approved. Padgett abstained. Follow-up recommendation to Zoning Commission that the portions now zoned R-2 and C-2 be changed to I-G.
11. Follow up to be made on cleaning up properties of Beamer gin, Beamer barn, College Street School and Woods. Hoyt Edwards to follow up.
12. The Mayor brought up matter of complaint from Mrs. Miller on vacant house on Second Ave. owned by Mrs. L. A. Roach as not fit for human habitation. Also property of Mrs. J. C. Owens on south side of Nelson St. Owners to be notified to upgrade or demolish within 30 days. Motion by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Collins. Motion approved.

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13. Roy Fox reported on pipe prices for King Street ditch project. Account of high cost of pipe, this project will be delayed.
14. Motion by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Lewis to approve the following water taps, Kenneth Wheat, Frank Kirby and Howard Boling. Motion approved.
15. Hoyt Edwards reported that Ben Holden wants to salvage materials from landfill. It was consensus that this is an undesirable situation and Police be instructed to warn parties so doing to stop the practice.
16. Motion to adjourn by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Lewis. Motion approved.
