



JUNE 24, 1974 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT
EXCEPT ALD. MATHEWS.

1. Invocation given by Rev. John Allen.
2. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.
3. Application for malt pouring license of Pauline Tucker dba Country House Restaurant read. Motion to approve by Ald. Lewis 2nd by Ald. Padgett. Done. Mayor expressed he was opposed to the granting of any beer license.
4. Motion to adopt speed detection device and dispense with 1st and 2nd readings by Ald. Lewis, 2nd by Ald. Padgett, done.
5. Motion to approve one water tap by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Lewis, carried.
6. Street Department instructed to erect barricades on S. Piedmont (Dr. Johnson property), Steep Ditch Hazard.
7. Gus Cate requested \$23,600 for school board to finish fiscal year in the black. Motion to approve by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Padgett, carried.
8. School board presented budget for fiscal year 1974-75 of \$512,000. This includes \$12,000 for a green house which state will match \$12,000. Request for Bond Issue of \$400,000 for stadium discussed. Mayor recommended appraisals of buildings adjacent to school property.
9. James Black heard on walkway for pedestrians and bike trail leading to new recreation area. Referred to Hoyt Edwards for estimates.
10. Don Watt of TLM Associates presented plan for water treatment plant. Motion by Ald. Lewis to accept low bid of Aurora Pump 2nd by Ald. Padgett, carried. Mr. Watt also discussed filters at plant. Roy Fox to check on available Federal money. Motion to let bids on filters by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Collins, carried.
11. Mr. Nicolas of Holland Motel requested annexation into City. Roy Fox and Hoyt Edwards to report back at next council meeting.
12. Mrs. Crump requested bringing a mobile home into the City. Council denied permission.
13. Shortage of water in Antioch tank discussed. No new water taps on east side, outside city limits on a motion by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Collins, done.
14. Ald. Lewis discussed combined City-County NARCO Squad, further report to be made.
15. Motion to adjourn by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Collins, done.
