

1. Invocation given by Mayor Burdette.
2. Minutes read and approved.
3. Harold Faith complained of streets in Fox Subdivision, also asked about annexing property to get sewer service. Mayor advised him to get petition signed and promised to get to work on street repairs this week.
4. Bill Tinch related case of his sons and J. C. Kay in Mr. Kay's garden. Discussion followed. Mayor Burdette called for vote on revocation of J.C. Kay's malt license. Ald. Mathews requested delay until Superior Court decision. Probation for store until decision. Mayor dismissed charges against Mr. Tinch's sons.
5. Motion by Ald. Padgett to include fuel adjustment in power bills, beginning with August billing (since Dec., 1972, date used by Southeastern Consulting Engineers, Inc., to recommend new rate schedule fuel adjustment was not included), 2nd by Ald. Collins and unanimously approved.
6. Bruce Bowman told Council that Mr. and Mrs. Frank Hutchinson, who were present, had sanitary sewer problems. Ald. Padgett moved, 2nd by Ald. Mathews to replace City's sewer, voted and passed with Ald. Lewis requesting College St. not be cut unless necessary.
7. Mr. Nicolas, re signs at Motel, Mayor promised an answer at July 22 meeting.
8. Jack Knight complained that Council was not adhering to its own regulations in issuing license for sale of malt beverages. Mr. Knight asked that all licensees be treated alike. All licensees to receive updated copy of malt beverage ordinance to be sent to all license holders.
9. Don Watt of TLM Associates repeated that Aurora's bid will not be honored by the Company as a firm bid and Council authorized contract be awarded Peerless on a motion by Ald. Padgett, 2nd Ald. Mathews and passed.
10. Ald. Padgett, re water taps in Amakanata Subdivision, Bruce Bowman said situation is under control, but we don't have adequate water east of City. Don Watt said study needs to be made of water system. Ald. Padgett moved, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, voted and passed for TLM to conduct study.
11. Ald. Padgett moved to make water taps two for Milton Stewart in Amakanata Subdivision and one for James C. Taylor on Hunt Gin Rd. 2nd by Ald. Lewis and approved.
12. Ald. Lewis moved to employ NARCO Squad with County paying half of the expenses, 2nd by Ald. Mathews and passed.
13. Ald. Collins said can't make a right turn from Hillcrest onto Cherry Hill and Cherry Hill and Peters dangerous intersection.



15. Thurman Roberts built house on Ivy Lane in Briarwood Sub. Discussed. Council decided not to connect electric service until house meets National Electrical Code.
16. Ronald Robinson's car damaged by tree limb. He was instructed to turn in claim to his insurance company.
17. Ald. Collins moved to adjourn and 2nd by Ald. Lewis.
