


APRIL 22, 1974 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALD. PADGETT  
ABSENT

1. Invocation given by Rev. John Allen.
2. Minutes read and approved.
3. A group of citizens of the New Zion Community appeared protesting the location of the New Industrial Landfill. The Mayor is to speak to the County Commissioner to locate a different site if at all possible.
4. Motion by Ald. Mathews to approve 6 water taps for Hall Realty at Woodridge estates, Sammy Wyatt, lot 62 Amakanata, Carl England, Red Bud Rd., Bobby Crowder, Memorial Road, Fred Bagley, 110 Victor St., and Tommy Smith, Baxter Rd., 2nd by Ald. Collins, Carried.
5. Roy Fox brought up approximately 10 sewer taps in Parkland. Line was relocated. Motion by Ald. Collins not to charge for sewer taps but property owners would have to connect at their own expense, 2nd by Ald. Lewis, carried.
6. The hearing of the Holcomb property rezoning his property on S. Industrial Circle. Not Contest. Council agreed to rezone.
7. Ald. Mathews requested Hoyt Edwards to contact Ed Duvall and be sure a wall of sufficient height and strength be erected at the College Street School during demolition.
8. Jack Bell presented a proposal for street lights in Devonwood. Estimated cost of \$1700.00 plus labor. Motion by Ald. Lewis to proceed, 2nd by Ald. Collins, carried.
9. Ald. Collins instructed Roy Fox to proceed with water connections on Adair Street. Mr. Fox said this would be done as soon as possible.
10. Jack Bell recommended Venture Carpet be contacted to enlist their aid in the city supplying power to their new facility. Hoyt Edwards to contact Venture.
11. Clerk read ordinance for speed detection devices. Motion by Ald. Lewis, 2nd by Ald. Collins to dispense with 2nd reading. Motion to adopt by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, carried.
12. Roy Fox heard on pond at the library. The Council instructed the Parks Department to clean the pond daily.
13. Mayor Burdette pointed out that over the weekend he observed manholes not covered and no warning lights posted for work being done for the City. Hoyt Edwards to have this corrected.
14. Motion to adjourn by Ald. Lewis, 2nd by Ald. Collins, done.
