

MARCH 25, 1974 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT
EXCEPT ALD. TED COLLINS.

1. Invocation given by Roy Fox.
2. Minutes read and approved.
3. Mrs. Beth Bennett of Volunteer Action requested use of the old recreation department station wagon. County to pay \$1,000, City to pay \$1,000. Motion to approve by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, carried.
4. Ald. Lewis and Chief Hayes heard on radar unit for City at a proposed cost of \$1,395.00. Discussion followed. Motion to buy unit by Ald. Lewis, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, carried.
5. Chief Hayes heard on Piedmont and Line Sts. intersection, he requested a right turn lane. Ald. Lewis requested a cost estimate on widening Piedmont from Line St. to Trammell St. from Roy Fox.
6. Hoyt Edwards presented bills for Chamber of Commerce \$1500 and GMA legal action on power suit \$2711.00. Motion by Ald. Mathews to pay, 2nd by Ald. Padgett, carried.
7. Power Suit to be appealed by C. Adams.
8. Power to Bonanza discussed Mayor instructed Hoyt Edwards to contact the City Attorney in this regard.
9. Roy Fox heard on parking in front of Police Station. Referred to Roy Fox for cost estimate on parking lot behind City Hall.
10. Reflective street signs would cost 2.00 per intersection, *INCREASE*. Council would prefer these be used in the future.
10. Bruce Bowman heard on water line problem. Cost of 8" line over 2" line approximately \$10,000, labor cost the same. Total cost of \$13,000 for 8". Motion by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Mathews to extend a line on Bellwood Road approximately 2600' to the intersection of Richardson Rd. and Bellwood Rd.
11. Contract on Carolina Freight brought up. Motion to approve predicated upon City Attorney's approval by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Padgett, carried.
12. Ald. Lewis discussed parking downtown.
13. Motion to sell police car and Chevelle at auction by Ald. Mathews, 2nd by Ald. Lewis, carried.
14. Motion to adjourn by Ald. Padgett, 2nd by Ald. Mathews, done.


