Sept. 8, 1958

City Council met in regular session with all members present.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Frank Dickinson.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk and approved by the mayor and council.

Council approved of getting a patch job on the old roof at the Civic Center in lieu of a bid of \$ 550.00. Frank Johnson had stated that he thought a patch job would do just as good.

Mr. Joe Woodall of the Liberty Community requested the council to run water to his property. Since it was quite a distance from the end of the present line to the Woodall property the council only agreed to run the line for a distance of 100 feet along the public road and no distance across the hill toward the Woodall property. Council agreed to dig the ditch for the line if the terrain was level.

Council agreed on Tuesday night Sept. 16th, 1958 for the annual "gripe" night for people to appear before the council that wasn't satisfied with their property taxes. Agreed to meet at 7:30 pm at the City Hall. Agreed to send all people notices that had been raised even though no return was made and agreed to send a notice that 10% penalty would be added to all persons returns not making a return.

Miss Ruby Brock of a College Street address stated to a member of the Council that when the city cut the old water line loose at her house to install city water the hot water tank at her home drained causing the unit to burn out and requested the city to purchase a new one for the tank. After discussion Mr. Dickinson made a motion that the bill of approximately \$9.00 be paid to Gaines Appliance Company seconded by Mr. Spink voted on and passed.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
