City council met in regular session with all members present.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Supt. of City Schools A. A. Graves.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk and adopted by the council.

Mr. Howard Kirby of a Wander Street Address was present and ask the City Council to change the name of Wander Street to Talley Avenue. Mr. Kirby stated that he had a petition with twenty nine signers asking for the name change. Stated that the street was now confusing as wanders everywhere and people call all streets in that section Wander Street. After discussion Alderman Bill Spink made a motion that the present name of Wander Street be changed to Talley Avenue and that Crest Drive be extended South to the Rome Road or Highway 53". This motion seconded by Alderman David voted on and passed.

Mr. Doyle Phillips and Mr. A. B. Richards were present in the interest of the proposed new armory for the city and ask the council for permission to use the city streets for a muster day parade on Feb. 22, 1958. Also ask permission to block Court Street from Park Avenue to the Railroad Crossing. After discussion the council granted permission of the streets and assured the delegation that the city would take immedate steps to help with the new armory. Mr. David asked that a resolution be entered in the minutes of said meeting stating that the city was solidly behind the move of getting construction started on the new armory. Also that the city notify its Senators and Congressmen and ask them to do all in their power to get the construction started. The resolution was adopted by the council.

Mrs. Buddy Norton, Mr. Bert Lance, Mr. A. A. Graves of the recreation committee were present to report their findings to the council about financing a recreation program. The group stated that it take approximately \$3220.00 to finance a summer program for the year 1958. With the help of the school and Junior Woman's Club a good program could be started with this amount. Also stated that it would take approximately \$7000.00 for the year 1959. After much discussion Mr. David suggested that revenue from the parking meters be used to finance a recreation program and that Mrs. Buddy Norton, Vassa Cate, R. D. Walter, S.M. Harrison and J. H. Hobgood be appointed as a recreation committee that would be in charge of the program and in charge of funds for the program and would be responsible to the City Council. Mr. Lance suggested the first step would be to adopt a recreation ordinance. Mr. David made a motion that recreation ordinance (COPY ATTACHED) be adopted as read. This motion seconded by Mr. Spink voted on and passed.

Mr. David made a motion that \$3220.00 be set up in a recreation fund from the revenue of the parking meters to be used by the recreation commission in the calendar year 1958 with the first payment of \$320.00 per month to start March 1, 1958. Also that the payments be increased to \$600.00 per month starting January 1, 1959. This money to be in charge of the recreation commission appointed by the mayor and council. That this commission be responsible to the council for its actions. This motion second by Mr. Spink voted on and passed.

The Police and Street Committies made the following recomendations to the Mayor and Council: (1) that a set of steps be built at the colored housing project (2) A ditch be cleaned out at the white project (3) widen North Wall Street from Harlan Street to Trammell Street approximately 10 feet on East Side- permit parrell parking on the East Side where Widening takes place(4) permit no parking on Line Street from College to Wall Street. Mr. Spink made a motion that the recommendations presented be carried out by the City. This motion seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

Mr. David made a motion that the following pay scale be put into effect at the next pay period. Copy of Pay Scale Attached. This motion seconded by Mr. Spink voted on and passed.

Purchase of new garbage truck discussed with bids from Owens-Prater Ford and Davis Bros. Chev. Co. being opened at this time. The bids were:  
Davis Bros. Chev. Co. Net Bid \$2529.78 -----Owens-Prater \$2529.23 Net.  
After discussion Mr. Spink made a motion that a new motor and paint job be done on the old truck seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
