City Council met in regular session with all members present.

Alderman Frank Dickinson opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

City Engineer Alton McDaniel Jr. reported that the following work had been completed: A 6 inch water line had been installed along Maulding Road to Thomas Street from the filter plant. This would relieve the high water problem that now existed. Water line from the intersection of the 41 Highway and Highway 225 to the corner at the Elks Club had been connected.

Mr. Spink suggested that school zone signs be placed in the streets near the schools as he thinks this will help people be conscious of the fact that they are near a school.

Mr. Woods states that the houses in the city and the surrounding areas need house numbers. Thinks the Jaycees might be interested in such a project Suggest that they and other civic organizations be contacted and see if they would be interested in the project.

Mr. Dickinson states that he wants the city to start around the 24th of November putting up the Christmas Decorations. Would like to see the lights turned on by December 1, 1958. Stated that he was trying to hold the cost to \$300.00 for the decorations.

Council agreed to close the City Hall for one day November 27th for Thanksgiving.

Mr. Dickinson made a motion that \$35.00 to \$40.00 be spent for flowers to beautify the front of the City Hall. This motion seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.

Mr. David made a motion that the expense for two policemen to attend an F.B.I. School at Georgia Tech on the 13th of November be paid by the City. This motion seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.

Mr. David stated that a Civil Defense School at Macon would be held on the 19th of November and ask the council for permission to use one of the police cars to make the trip. Council granted permission.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
