City Council met at the City Hall in regular session with Alderman David, and Dickinson and Mayor Edwards present. Alderman Woods and Spink absent. Alderman Woods being away with the Georgia Guard and Alderman Spink away on vacation.

Chief Hayes opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

Mr. R.C. Berger was present and ask the council for permission to sell ice cream and snowballs from the street at the corner of North Wall and Line Streets. The council stated that were against this and would not issue a license for such a business. Mr. Berger then ask the council for a license to sell ice cream and snowballs along with fruits from a private lot on North Wall Street. The lot in question being the John R. keys lot on North Wall Street. The Council instructed Mr. Berger to go from house to house and get the property owners near the Keys lot to sign a petition syng they had no objection to the business and the council would vote on this at the next meeting.

Mr. Terrell Greeson was present at the meeting and stated to the council that some dogs had been dragging dead pigs from the city dump over on his property and that he was afraid his hogs would catch some kind of disease from the dead animals. He requested the city to build a fence to keep the animals from his property. Council agreed to build a fence across the rest of the City Dump property to seperate the Greeson property from the City property. The fence not being the line but used for protection only.

It was reported that Mr. Lee Evans had moved his beer license from one location to another without permission from the council, Council instructed Chief Hayes to look into the matter.

Mr. David reported that Mr. Sam Boston wanted the city to build him a sewer line since his old private line was giving trouble. This matter tabled for time being.

Mr. David reported that the Governor of Okla. and the president of "Phillip 66" Oil Company was coming to Calhoun on July 27th for the dedication of New Echota. Mr. David ask the City to mow the weeds around the place. Council requested Mr. David to contact the State Highway Dept.


Mayor Edwards stated that he had had some complaints about low water preasure on Wander Street. Mr. McDaniel reported that the plan was under way to relieve the situation.
