

Calhoun, Georgia
March 24, 1958

City Council met in regular session with all members present.

Chief Hayes opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of Previous meeting Read by The Clerk AND ADOPTED by The Council.
Parking on East Line Street from North Wall to College discussed. City Engineer McDaniel reported that three lanes of traffic could be marked off on Line Street. Alderman Bill Spink made a motion that East Line Street from North Wall to College be marked for three lanes with the North Side Lane being marked for parking and the other two for through traffic. This motion seconded by Alderman Dickinson. Alderman Woods, Spink, and Dickinson voted for and Alderman David voted against the motion.

Alderman David ask permission from the council for the use of city equipment in fixing the track and other recreation fields at the city schools. Stated that Calhoun was centrally located and a lot of events among the schools were planned for the city. Council granted permission for use of equipment.

Mr. David expressed his appreciation and stated he felt sure the public felt the same way about the way Mayor Edwards and the Calhoun Newspapers *INC.* put the facts before the public on the matter of extending the city limits of the City of Calhoun. Thought this should be entered in the minutes of the City of Calhoun.

The Mayor and Council appointed Mr. J. H. Hobgood for a period of one year, Mr. Jack Boston Jr. for a period of 3 years, Mr. Beverly Langford for a period of 5 years to serve on the Calhoun-Gordon County Planning Commission.

Mayor Edwards read a letter from Mr. J. Fred Daniels the supervisor of the State Peace Officer's Training School commending the local police department for their fine department and the close contact between the department and the city officials. Also for the leadership of Mr. Crofford Hayes, Chief of the department.

Mayor Edwards read a letter from the city school board requesting the city council to take into consideration calling for a \$60,000.00 bond issue to be used for classrooms, a band room, and enlarging the seating capacity at the football field along with restrooms.

There being no other business to come before the meeting the council was adjourned.
