City Council met in regular session with all members present.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Chief Hayes.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk and approved by the council.

Dependent coverage under the group plan now in force was discussed. It has been discovered that the dependent wife has no coverage from the city plan if she was covered under another group plan. Mayor Edwards appointed a committee to look into the insurance plan and see what could be worked out.

Mr. Tom David stated that the ~~Junior Woman's Club~~ wanted the city to purchase some dogwood trees for the local parks. Mayor Edwards appointed the Street and Police Committees to work out some of the problems of the parks and the parking hazards facing the city at this time.

Mr. Frank Dickinson stated that he had talked to Mr. J. T. Barton Jr. about the curb and gutter bill due the city by Mr. Barton. Stated that Mr. Barton wanted to have someone fix his driveway and let the city pay the bill since he felt that it wasn't properly fixed by the city at the time of construction. Mr. Barton stated that he would then pay his bill to the city. Mr. Dickinson made a motion that the bill of Mr. Barton be left on record against him and that the city would do its best to satisfy him by fixing his driveway. No action on the motion.

Mrs. Ola Littlefield requested that the city install a street light in front of her house on North Wall Street. After discussion it was decided that a street light here would cause confusion and request from other people for a light and the council denied the light.

Mr. Frank Dickinson made a motion to ~~resend~~ the January 13th 1958 motion to deny a Special Beer License to Mr. Lee Evans and grant Mr. Evans a License. This motion was seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.

Mr. Spink stated that Mr. Gene Moss wanted the city to build some steps at the Colored Project from the street to the sidewalk. Mayor Edwards referred the problem to the Street Committee for action.

The Council discussed the delinquent taxes and other past due bills due the city. It was decided that the clerk would make up a list of all past due accounts and turn them over to the city attorney for collection.

Mr. Woods made a motion that \$20,000.00 now in the Water ^{Revenue} and Sewerage Sinking Fund be placed on savings at the Calhoun National Bank to draw interest at 3%. This motion seconded by Mr. Spink voted on and passed.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned
