City Council met in regular session at the City Hall with all members present.

Alderman Frank Dickinson opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk and approved by the Council.

Alderman Dickinson made a motion that the City pay Mr. Raymond Bagwell the sum of \$600.00 for an easement to lay a sewerage line across his property to the Oothcalooga Creek from McConnell Road. This Line would cross approximately 800 feet of Mr. Bagwell's property. This motion was seconded by Mr. Woods voted on and passed.

Mr. Spink reported that a few citizens had requested to him that the City install a traffic light at the corner of Trammell and Wall Streets. Also stated that some people complained of the bad view at the corner of Piedmont and Trammell Streets. After discussion no action taken.

Mayor Edwards stated that he thought lining the streets off with traffic lanes helped the traffic situation throughout the city and suggested that Piedmont Street be lined from East Line Street to South Wall. No action taken.

Mr. Woods stated that complaints were coming to him about the bus parking in front of Mauldin Feed and Seed Company. The Council decided to try and work out something with all parties involved at an early date.

A Petition was read from property owners on Hunt Drive and Jackson Streets in the Hunt's Subdivision requesting the City to annex their property into the City Limits. Mr. John Hunt was absent from the meeting and there was some question as to how much property he wanted taken into the city therefore action by the council was delayed.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
