Mayor Burdette called the hearing to order and stated the procedures and reasons for the hearing.

Members of the complaining party stated their reason for filing the complaint.

1. Mrs. Lamar Greene stated that Mr. Crumley's dog had been a nuisance regarding turning over and spreading garbage through her yard. She stated that since the complaint had been filed and Mr. Crumley had been notified, he had kept his dog on his property. The dog belonging to Mr. Flemister continued to roam at will and spread garbage in her yard. She stated that on one occasion her daughter was riding her bike with other children down the street and the Flemister dog attacked a small dog belonging to one of the children. On another occasion the Flemister dog nipped her daughter on the heel while she was out with other children.

2. Mrs. James Hendricks complained that the Flemister dog attacked her small dog on her property causing her to pay a \$160.00 vet bill in order to save her dog's life. She stated that while the Flemister dog was not the only one responsible for spreading garbage in her yard, he was always there.

Mr. Bill Crumley responded to the complaints by saying that no one had complained to him and that he had been unaware of any problems until he received notice of the complaint with a date for the hearing. Since that time he has kept the dog confined to his property.

Mr. Flemister responded by saying that when his dog attacked Mrs. Hendricks' dog there were several more dogs in the fight. His son did go over and try to stop the fight.

Mayor Burdette ruled that Mr. Crumley should continue to keep his dog on his own property. He ruled that the Flemister dog should also be confined to his own yard or the dog would be banned from the city limits or destroyed. He charged the complaining party with the responsibility of reporting any occasions when the two dogs were outside of their yards.
