1. Mayor Burdette opened the meeting and gave the invocation.
 2. Minutes of the Nov. 27, 1978, regular meeting were read and approved.
 3. Mayor's Comments: Mayor Burdette stated that he and Ald. King would join the Mayor's Motorcade to Central State Hospital on Dec. 13, 1978, and to Rome Regional Hospital on Dec. 15, 1978.
 4. Alderman's Comments: Ald. Padgett requested the Clerk send prior notices to motel operators regarding the motel tax. Ald. Padgett inquired about the approved street light for West May Street.
Ald. Lewis and Police Chief Davis presented awards and letters of commendation to Corp. Michael Arnwine, Patrolman Garland Byrd and Sgt. Robert Messer for their outstanding performance on duties in a recent arrest of heavily armed juveniles. Mayor Burdette read a letter of commendation from the Calhoun Times regarding an attempted burglary of the business office. The letter commended Lt. Larry Bowen, Sgt. Randy Jackson, Patrolmen Sid Roberts, Keith Sitton, and Investigators Charles Hendrix and Jerry Sapp.
 5. Public Comments: City Supt. Hobgood read a letter from Environmental Protection Association regarding a water analysis of the City's water supply, as per the attached.
 6. Old Business: (a) A public hearing was held on the following beer/wine/liquor renewal license applications for 1979:

Ald. Cox made a motion to approve, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and approved.
 7. New Business: (a) Bids were opened on the garbage body for the tractor ordered on Nov. 27, 1978. Tri-State bid \$12,425.00 plus \$500.00 transportation charges; Williams Equipment bid \$13,963.00, delivered. Ald. Padgett made a motion to accept the low of bid of \$12,425.00, plus \$500.00 transportation charges, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.
(b) Discussion was held on the cost of materials and labor used to construct garbage dumpsters. Ald. Lewis made a motion to change the price from \$250.00 each to \$350.00 in order to recover material cost, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.
(c) City Supt. Hobgood distributed copies of a proposed city-county landfill contract and asked that these be discussed at length on Dec. 18, 1978.
(d) Ald. Padgett made a motion to adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign all contracts and documents from the Dept. of Natural Resources, Environmental Protection Division regarding a grant for water pollution control facilities. 2nd by Ald. King and approved.
(e) Ald. Cox made a motion to hold a public hearing on Dec. 18, 1978, on the following beer/wine/liquor renewal applications:
Liquor - Red Bud Liquor Store, Ince., Champ Kelley; Speedy's Spirits, James Owens; American Legion Post 47
Beer - American Legion Post 47; American Legion Post 555
Wine - Red Bud Liquor Store, Inc.; Ray's Package Store
2nd by Ald. King and approved.

(f) Ald. Padgett made a motion to change the regular scheduled meeting on Dec. 25, 1978, to Dec. 18, 1978, 2nd by Ald. Lewis and approved.

(g) The Clerk presented an application from Mr. and Mrs. J.B. Garren for a beer package store license for Bobby's located on N. Wall Street. Ald. Lewis made a motion to accept the application and set the public hearing for Jan. 8, 1979, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.

(h) The Clerk presented an application from Pizza Hut requesting a beer license for consumption on the premises. Mayor Burdette stated that he was opposed to any granting of a license because of the young people which frequent the business. Ald. Lewis made a motion to consider the application and asked that the public hearing be set for Jan. 8, 1979, 2nd by Ald. King and approved.

(i) Supt. Hobgood requested permission to hold the District Georgia Water and Pollution Control Association meeting in Calhoun during January, 1979. Ald. Lewis made a motion to allow the expenditures for the meeting of approximately \$250.00, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and approved.

(j) Supt. Hobgood presented proposed plans for the sewer line to the new hospital. The Council asked the Superintendent to proceed with the acquiring of right-of-ways.

(k) Ald. Padgett made a motion to present a certificate to Ed Duvall for past service performed for the City. 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved. The Clerk was requested to draw the certificate for presentment.

8. Ald. Padgett made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Lewis and approved.
