


November 28, 1977--7:30 P.M. Regular Council Meeting with Mayor Burdette, Ald. Lewis, Ald. Harwell, and Ald. Padgett Present

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and City Chaplain John Allen gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the November 14, 1977 Regular Meeting and November 21, 1977 Special Meeting were read and approved.
3. Mayor's Comments: (a) Mayor Burdette invited the Aldermen and City Administrators to attend the Motorcade to Central State Hospital on December 14, 1977.  
(b) The Mayor announced the Annual Mayor's Day to be held in Atlanta, January 15 and 16. He asked that those desiring to go, let the Clerk know by Thursday for pre-registration.
4. Aldermen's Comments: (a) Ald. Lewis asked that the City/County Contract for appointments to the Industrial Development Authority be drawn up as soon as possible since there were a couple of appointments that need to be made at the present time.  
(b) Ald. Harwell reported Mrs. Hugh Prater's complaint concerning the trash and noise problem from the Sonic Drive-In abutting their property. Supt. Hobgood was asked to visit the Drive-In and request assistance in solving these problems.
5. Old Business: (a) Ald. Lewis made a motion to waive the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th reading of the Hotel-Motel Tax Ordinance and approve as read November 14, 1977. Seconded by Ald. Harwell and approved.  
(b) County Administrator Joe Brewster explained the County's request for seven additional reserve parking spaces for County Officials and Dept. Heads. A general discussion followed, and Ald. Padgett made a motion to reserve the four remaining spaces on the south side of the Courthouse, and limit parking on the north side and in the center aisle to one hour. Seconded by Ald. Harwell and approved.  
(c) City Election Superintendent, Hoyt Edwards announced the official election results: For Mayor--W.C. Burdette, 614; J.H. Harwell, 283; Post 1 Alderman--Ed Lewis, 742; Post 2 Alderman--Herbert King, 521; John Wallace, 364; Post 4 City Board of Education--Perry Moore, 378, Jean Overby, 499; Post 5 City Board of Education--John D. Shelton, 755. Total votes cast 907.  
(d) Ald. Lewis made a motion authorizing Mayor Burdette to sign a Resolution requesting the Dept. of Transportation to locate a rest area north of Calhoun on I-75 with the City providing water. Seconded by Ald. Padgett and approved.  
(e) The Clerk stated that the Electric Refunds had been made to local citizens over the past two months period, with the exception of those prior residents with no forwarding address. These are to be held for the individuals for a reasonable period of time.  
(f) City Supt. Hobgood explained the bids for the City Auditorium and City Fire Hall on the base buildings, excluding any mechanical, electrical, plumbing contracts as per the attached. The Mayor announced a meeting to be held on Wednesday, November 30 at 10:00 a.m. to discuss possible changes for the Auditorium Contract and urged everyone to attend.
6. New Business: (a) The Clerk gave a first reading to an Amendment to the House Movers Ordinance.  
(b) Ald. Lewis made a motion to appoint John D. Shelton to fill the unexpired term of John Hughes to the Housing Authority Committee, seconded by Ald. Padgett and approved.  
(c) A request for a 1978 Beer License was presented for Pauline Cox Tucker of the Country House Restaurant. The Council acknowledged that no advertisement on the property or in the local paper was necessary since a license was held by the same party at the same location last year. The distance from schools, churches and other Beer Stores was considered. No adverse comments had been received from the public on the store. Ald. Harwell made a motion to approve the license for 1978, seconded by Ald. Lewis and approved.
7. Ald. Padgett made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Ald. Harwell and approved.
