City Council met in regular session at the city hall with all members present.

Rev. A. B. Elzier, Pastor of First Methodist Church, was present at the session and opened the meeting with prayer. This was to be Rev. Elzier's last week in Calhoun as he is retiring and moving to Cartersville.

Mr. Bill Mathews of the Starr-Mathews Insurance Agency was present at the meeting and stated that the city was entitled to a 30% discount on it's fire insurance if a 90% sound value was carried on all buildings. Mr. Mathews stated that a survey had been made of the buildings and that a 90% value could be carried on the buildings without any increase in cost. Alderman Dickinson made a motion that 90% value be carried on the buildings. This motion received a second from alderman Norton was voted on and passed.

Mr. Luke Spink and Mr. Marvin Taylor appeared before the council in behalf of the Gordon County Hospital Board and ask the City of Calhoun to sell the Gordon County Hospital electric power at cost to the city. After discussion alderman Norton made a motion that the <sup>city</sup> sell the Gordon County Hospital electric power at 1¢ per KW. This motion received a second from alderman David voted on and passed.

Raymond Abbott, a colored citizen, appeared before the council and requested a beer license for the Indiana Inn on Alexander Street. After discussion alderman Dickinson made a motion that the license be refused at this location. This motion received a second from alderman Norton voted on and passed.

Alderman Dickinson made a motion that the \$50.00 check for a lunch room and juke box license applied for by Fairbanks Long but paid for by C. L. Neal of Barnesville, Georgia be returned to Mr. Neal. Mr. Dickinson included in his motion that the \$200.00 Cash bond deposited with the city by Faribanks Long be forfeited for violation of the malt beverage ordinance. This motion received a second from alderman David voted on and passed.

Alderman David made a motion that Mr. H.T. Jones be appointed to the Housing Authority Board to fill the unexpired term of the late Emmett Walraven. This motion received a second from alderman Dickinson voted on and passed. Other members of the board being Mr. James Keene, Tom Shanahan, Paul Smith, Hastings Scoggins.

Mayor Edwards and Supt. James Owens reported on the Georgia Municipal Convention held at Jekyll Island and expressed appreciation to the city for the priveledge of representing the city at said convention.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
