City Council met in regular session at the city hall with mayor-pro-tem Frank Dickinson presiding. All members were present except Mayor Edwards.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk and approved by the council.

Alderman Norton made a motion that Sequoyah Terrace be made a one way street and paved from the old reservoir to the first house on Hicks Street. This motion received a second from alderman Woods voted on and passed.

Alderman David requested that the city clean up the broken bottles and trash around the ball park and swimming pool. Supt. Owens stated that this would be taken care of.

Alderman David requested that the city delay action on fencing the proposed play area at the corner of Pine and Fair Streets.

Alderman David requested the use of the city backhoe at the Gordon County gun club on Saturday or after working hours. Stated the Recreation and Police Departments would use the gun ranges when finished. Council granted said request.


Police Chief R. C. Hayes ask the council if the city would be interested in taking up the payments in the amount of \$1243.00 on the parking meters owned by the county. Council decided to leave the matter up to the mayor and chief to work out details.

Supt. James Owens stated that some changes in personnel had taken place since the last meeting. Stated that Rex Prater and Jack Sellers had left the city employment. Jack Bell had been placed in charge of the electric, water and sewer departments. Joe Garrett had been placed in charge of meter reading and Buddy Autry had been hired as a meter reader. Billy Lackey had been transferred to the electric department and Pink Langston had been transferred back to the electric department.

Bids on approximately \$20,000.00 worth of cast iron pipe were discussed by the council. This pipe being a part of the waterworks improvement being carried out with the enlargement of the water filter plant. ~~company~~. Alderman David made a motion that McWane Cast Iron Pipe Company of Birmingham, Alabama be awarded an order for the pipe since they were low bidder. This motion was seconded by alderman Woods voted on and passed.

There being no other business alderman David made a motion to adjourn seconded by alderman Woods voted on and passed.
