City council met in regular session at the city hall with all members present except alderman W. R. Norton.

Alderman Frank M. Dickinson opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk and approved by the council.

Supt. James Owens stated to the council that the present front-end loader owned by the city was in bad need of repair and was in a bad mechanical condition. After discussion the council instructed Mr. Owens to get bids on the purchase of a new loader and see what kind of financing could be worked out.

The purchase of a new billing machine was discussed by the council. After discussion alderman Dickinson made a motion that the purchase of the new machine be left up to the city clerk and for him to use his own judgement toward the purchase of said machine. This motion was seconded by alderman Woods voted on and passed.

Mayor Edwards reported that the committee on group insurance for the city and its employees had decided on the \$25.00 deductible policy and instructed the clerk to make arrangements to have the policy changed to the \$25.00 deductible.


Alderman Dickinson made a motion that the city purchase enough paint for the swimming pool and let the recreation department paint said pool. This motion was seconded by alderman Woods voted on and passed.

Passing of an electrical, plumbing, and building code was discussed by the council. Alderman Dickinson suggested that the Mayor, City Supt., City Clerk, and City Attorney get together on drawing up a code and present their work before the council for consideration.

Supt. James Owens stated that a job order for a chain link fence around the little league park had been given to City Tin and Awning Co. of Rome, Georgia, and the job should be completed within a short time. The cost of the fence was \$1,075.00.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
