City Council met in regular session at the city hall with all members present .

Police Chief R.C. Hayes opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Clerk and approved by the council.

Supt. James Owens stated to the council that he had received bids from Owens-Prater Ford and Davis Brothers for the purchase of a new truck for the garbage department. The bids were as follows:

Owens Prater Ford----\$2728.00
Davis Brothers ----- 2664.56

Supt. Owens also had a bid on a new Pack-Mor body from the Decatur Truck and Tractor Company in the amount of \$4195.00 less \$1000 trade in on the old body. After discussion Mr. Norton made a motion that the City of Calhoun purchase the Chevrolet truck and the Pack-Mor Body. This motion received a second from Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.


Mr. David stated that the Recreation Department had requested that the area between the present baseball field and Pine Street that the city had purchased be fenced and made into a little league lighted baseball field. Also that the windows and doors at the swimming pool needed replacing. After discussion Mr. David made a motion that the windows and doors at the pool be fixed and the recreation area be studied by the city superintendent to determine what would be the best action to take. This motion received a second from alderman Norton voted on and passed.

Alderman Norton made a motion that the new street through Cherry Hill subdivision from Peters Street to Hillcrest Drive be named Hillhouse Drive in honor of Mr. Laurens Hillhouse who was an outstanding citizen of the city. This motion was seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.

Supt. Owens stated to the council that a concrete sidewalk to the Junior High School along River Street from Oothcalooga would cost approximately \$1040 and a hot plant mix would cost approximately \$475.00. Council delayed any action on the matter.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
